# **LEVEL 3: ADVANCED**

Your student is well prepared for the next grade or course.

# **LEVEL 2: SATISFACTORY**

Your student is sufficiently prepared but may need short-term help to be successful in the next grade or course.

# **LEVEL 1: UNSATISFACTORY**

Your student is not prepared for the next grade or course. Strong academic support is needed.
