Campus NWEA Growth and Achievement Data K-5

- Baseline is the 50th percentile; anything above the 50th percentile is good. All content made growth at or above the 50th percentile. Math 56, Reading 50, Science, 59, Reading Spanish 68.
- Our GT and Asian group made the highest growth.
- Areas of concern: Low growth for SpEd and Reading data lower than the other content.
- Science data was high on achievement and growth. RLA teacher shared that most of the RLA text used in class aligned with content that was taught in class. Students were able to benefit from crosscurricular connections.
- **DIBELS k-1**: The number of students scoring at or above benchmark doubled from 20. 23% on the BOY to 45.82% on the MOY.
- Lectura K-1: Increase of 13.96 at or above benchmark from BOY to MOY.
 69.59% scored at or above benchmark.
