IMAGINE

STILL LIFE

Still Life

A **still-life** is a picture of objects that don't move. Often vases, bowls of fruit, bottles etc. The artist sets up a still-life usually in the studio to do a 'study' of the objects. It may be a drawing or a painting.

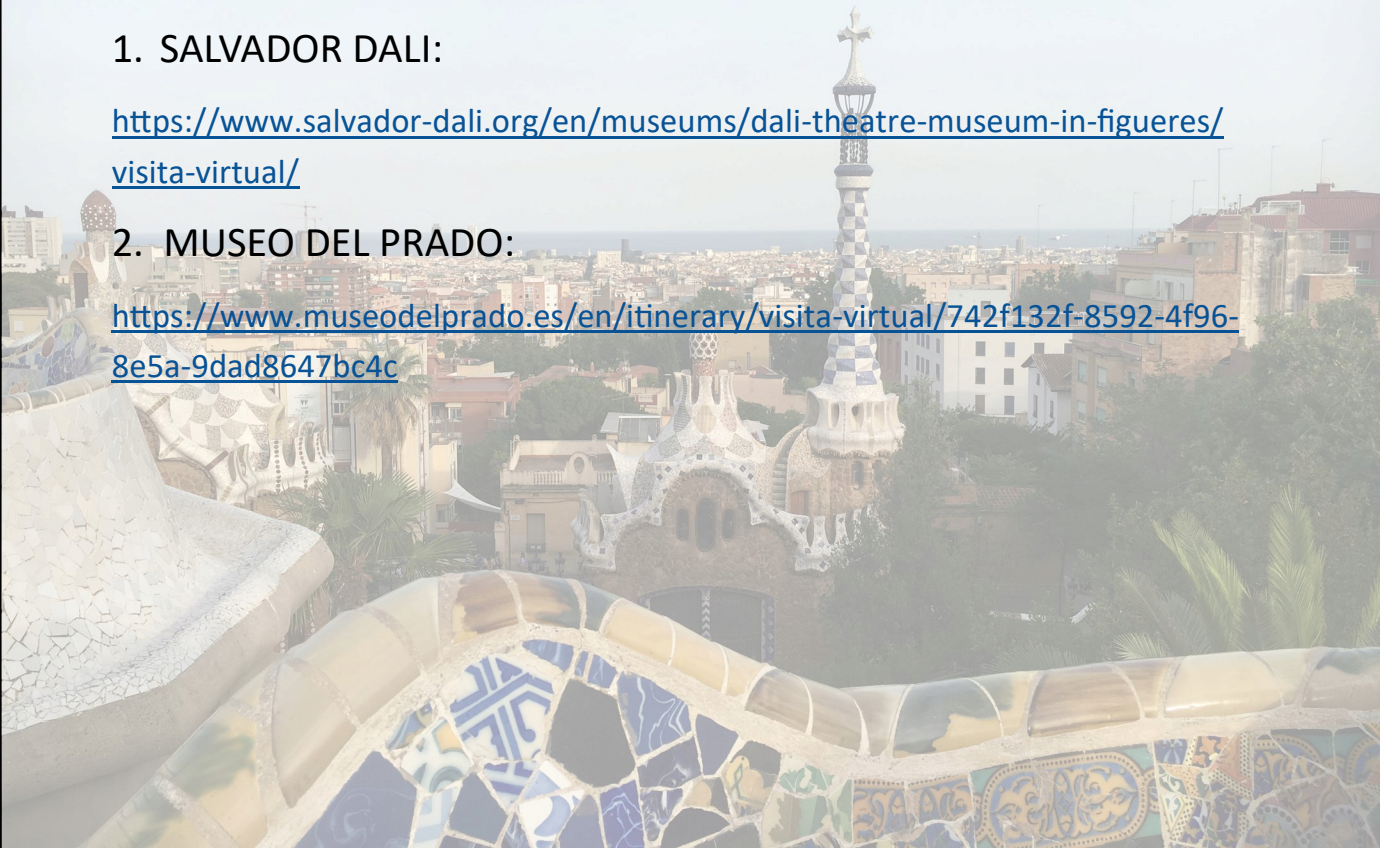
