-Students will recite numbers forward by 1's and 10's to 120 and count backwards by 1's from 100.

-Students will skip count by fives and tens to determine the total number of objects in a set up to 100.

Science Vocabulary

(Students are expected to know the meanings of the vocabulary and be able to use them in Chinese and English.)

- Temperature: A measure of how hot or how cold something is.
- Heat/ thermal energy: Energy that makes things warmer.
- Freeze: To change from a liquid to a solid.
- Thermometer: A tool that measures temperature.
- Warm: Having or giving off heat.
- Cool: To have a fairly low temperature.
- Energy: Something that causes matter to move or change
- Source: The beginning or place of origin.
- Light: A kind of energy that lets us see.
- Natural: Materials found in nature.
- Human-Made: Materials made by people.
- Sound: A kind of energy that you can hear
- Movement: A change of position or place
