Science Vocabulary

(Students are expected to know the meanings of the vocabulary and be able to use them in Chinese and English.)

- Seasons: Times of the year that form a repeating pattern.
- Winter: The season that follows Fall and has the fewest hours of daylight.
- Summer: The season that follows Spring and has the most hours of daylight.
- Fall/ autumn: The season that follows Summer when the air gets cooler.
- Spring: The season between Winter and Summer where growth in nature is seen.
- Weather pattern: A change in the weather that repeats.
