What's Happening at HAIS the week of February 8, 2016



In Science, Technology, and Math this week:

Geometry students will use the relationships among the sides in special right triangles.

Pre-Calculus students will find the exact values of the trigonometric functions using even-odd properties.

AP Calculus students will calculate, interpret, and apply integrals.

Pre-AP Physics students will study sound waves, sound intensity and Doppler-effect.

AP Physics students will be studying gravitation.

In Pre-AP Biology, students will categorize objects using a classification system and be able to use a dichotomous key.

In Algebra, students will set up and solve quadratics and radical equations.

In Pre-AP Chemistry the students will practice more on solutions and solubility and will be tested on this topic.

In AP/ Dual credit Chemistry the students will start learning about equilibrium.

In Statistics, students will review Inference and study for the Unit 5 Test.

In Geometry, students will use inequalities in triangles to solve problems.

Here's What's Happening in the Humanities this week:

APUSH students will identify, trace, analyze, and evaluate US participation before, during, and after World War I.

Business English students will be presenting their student-taught grammar lesson projects and will practice writing SAT timed essays.

AP Language and Composition students will be writing in-class synthesis essays over their previous in-class readings.

AP British Literature students will begin poetic analysis by studying ballads and lyric poetry.

In Model United Nations, students will discuss the need for ethnical food supply, and research and write a position paper for the next class simulation.

In Pre-AP English, students will finish reading/acting Romeo and Juliet and continue their scene presentations.

In AP Human Geography, students will continue researching the historical background of their regional conflicts. Our class will also be celebrating Chinese New Year on Friday February 12th.

English II students will take a benchmark assessment and practice poetry annotations in preparation for their poetry projects.

Students in AP World History will be studying Asia and its connection to foreign traders.
