The attached report summarizes the final accountability ratings released by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) on December 12, 2018. TEA released preliminary ratings under the new A–F system on August 15, 2018. HISD appealed three of the preliminary ratings, and TEA granted the appeal for Shearn Elementary School changing its rating from Improvement Required to Met Standard. The other two were denied. Districts received A–F ratings this year while campuses received *Met Standard* or *Improvement Required* ratings. In addition, any campus or district that qualified for the Hurricane Harvey provision and would have otherwise received an *Improvement Required* (Campus) or a *B*, *C*, *D*, or *F* (District) rating was labeled *Not Rated: Harvey Provision*.

Key findings include:

- The district received a rating of ***Not Rated: Harvey Provision*** for the 2017–2018 school year. If not for the Hurricane Harvey provision, the district would have received a *B* rating.
- **252** out of the **275** campuses that were rated (**92 percent**) were assigned a *Met Standard* rating, while **six** campuses (**2 percent**) were rated improvement required.
- 17 out of the 275 rated campuses (**6 percent**) received a *Not Rated: Harvey Provision* label, including two campuses without their own data that were paired with the district.
- 19 out of the 27 campuses (**70 percent**) rated *Improvement Required* in 2016–2017 were assigned a *Met Standard* rating, one was not rated this year, and seven campuses received a *Not Rated: Harvey Provision* label.
- 243 campuses were eligible this year for Distinction Designations
- 152 campuses (**63 percent** of those eligible) received at least one Distinction Designation.
- 19 campuses (**8 percent** of those eligible) received every eligible Distinction Designation.

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Texas Education Agency Final Accountability Ratings Report 2017–2018

The 2018 accountability system uses a performance framework that consists of three domains. Detailed information on each of the three domains, including construction of the domains, scoring tables, minimum size requirements and exclusions can be found in the Texas Education Agency's (TEA) 2018 Accountability Manual which can be downloaded from the [Research and Accountability website](#). TEA's overview is provided in **Appendix A**. The three domains are:

Domain 1 – Student Achievement

Evaluates performance across all subjects for all students, on both general and alternate assessments, College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) indicators, and graduation rates.

Domain 2 – School Progress

Measures district and campus outcomes in two areas: the number of students that grew at least one year academically (or are on track) as measured by STAAR results and the achievement of all students relative to districts or campuses with similar economically disadvantaged percentages.

Domain 3 – Closing the Gaps

Uses disaggregated data to demonstrate differentials among racial/ethnic groups, socioeconomic backgrounds and other factors. The indicators included in this domain, as well as the domain's construction, align the state accountability system with the federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).

Raw scores in each domain are converted to a consistent scale and weighted to give campuses and districts an overall rating. To receive a *Met Standard* rating, districts and campuses must have an overall rating calculation of at least 60 with 70% of the overall calculation coming from the better outcome of the Student Achievement and School Progress domains and 30% of the calculation coming from the Closing the Gaps domain. In addition, if a campus or district receives less than a scaled score of 60 in three of the four areas (Domain 1, 2A, 2B, or 3), then the highest overall scaled score possible is 59. The overall 2017–2018 ratings are based on the scaled score targets presented in **Table 1**.

Hurricane Harvey Provision

Districts and campuses throughout Texas were significantly impacted by Hurricane Harvey during the Fall of 2017. In response, the TEA has assigned all campuses that would have received an *Improvement Required* rating a label of *Not Rated* if they met one of the following four criteria:

- The campus identified 10 percent or more of enrolled students with a crisis code of 5a, 5b, or 5c.
- The campus reported 10 percent or more of its teachers experienced homelessness due to Hurricane Harvey, as reported in the Homeless Survey announced February 14, 2018.
- The campus was reported to TEA as closed for ten or more instructional days due to Hurricane Harvey.

- The campus was reported to TEA as displaced due to Hurricane Harvey either because the student population was relocated to another geographic location at least through winter break or the student population was required to share its own campus facility with the students of another campus closed as a direct result of Hurricane Harvey at least through winter break.

In addition, any district rated B, C, D, or F and either each of the district's campuses received a *Not Rated* label or 10 percent or more of the school district's students were reported on the October snapshot as enrolled in a campus labeled *Not Rated* under the Hurricane Harvey Provision received a *Not Rated: Harvey Provision* label in 2018.

This report provides a summary of the final 2017–2018 district and campus accountability ratings released by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) on December 12, 2018. Ratings were finalized after the appeals process was completed. HISD submitted three appeals. The appeal for Shearn Elementary School was accepted by the TEA changing its rating from Improvement Required to Met Standard. The other two were denied. This report updates the preliminary accountability ratings report to reflect these changes.

In 2018, both the Houston Independent School District and 17 campuses received a label of *Not Rated: Harvey Provision*. For purposes of counting consecutive years of ratings, 2017 and 2019 will be considered consecutive years for the school district and the *Not Rated* campuses.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to changes in the state accountability system, caution should be used when attempting to make any comparisons to prior year results.

Key Findings:

- The district received a label of *Not Rated: Harvey Provision* for the 2017–2018 school year.
- If not for the Hurricane Harvey provision, the district would have received a *B* rating.

- 252 out of the 275 campuses that were rated (92%) were assigned a *Met Standard* rating, while 6 campuses (2%) were rated *Improvement Required*.
- 17 out of the 275 campuses that were rated (6%) received a *Not Rated: Harvey Provision* label including two campuses paired with the district.

- 19 out of the 27 campuses (**70%**) rated *Improvement Required* last year were assigned a *Met Standard* rating. One campus rated *Improvement Required* last year did not receive a rating this year, and seven campuses received a *Not Rated: Harvey Provision* label.

- 243 campuses were eligible this year for Distinction Designations.
- 152 campuses (**63%** of those eligible) received at least one Distinction Designation.
- 19 campuses (**8%** of those eligible) received every eligible Distinction Designation.

Complete scoring information on all campuses can be found in **Tables 7–9**, TEA's accountability summary reference is provided in **Appendix A**, and TEA's complete list of indicators for the distinction designations are listed in **Appendix B**.

All campuses serving grades PK–12 must receive an accountability rating. However, campuses with no state assessment results due to grade span served (i.e. PK–2) are incorporated into the accountability system by having districts choose another campus within the same district or the district itself with which to pair for accountability purposes. These campuses receive a rating based solely on the paired campus' or district's performance. These campuses, along with their pairs, are also identified in **Table 7**. Campuses that do not receive a rating due to an insufficient number of tested students or because their results are attributed to their students' home campuses are identified in **Table 5**. Campuses receiving a *Not Rated* label due to the Hurricane Harvey Provision are identified in **Table 6**.
