 - English Learner (EL)

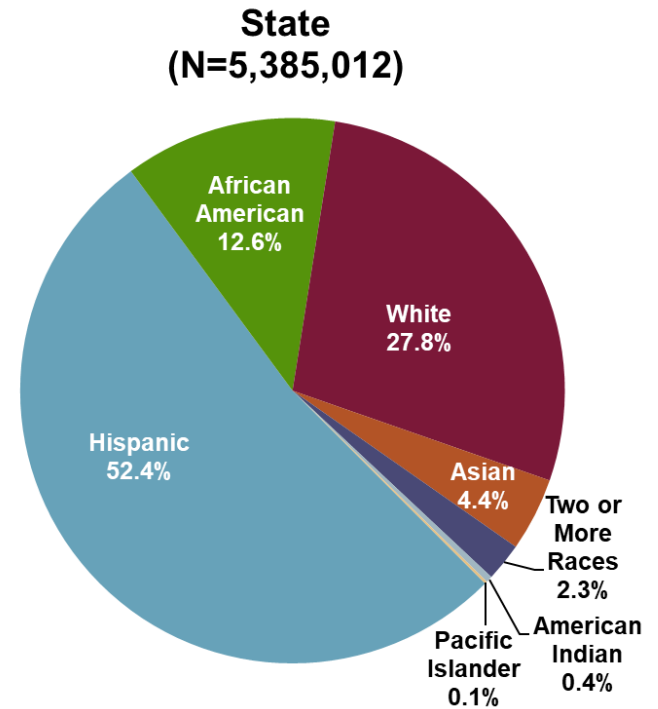
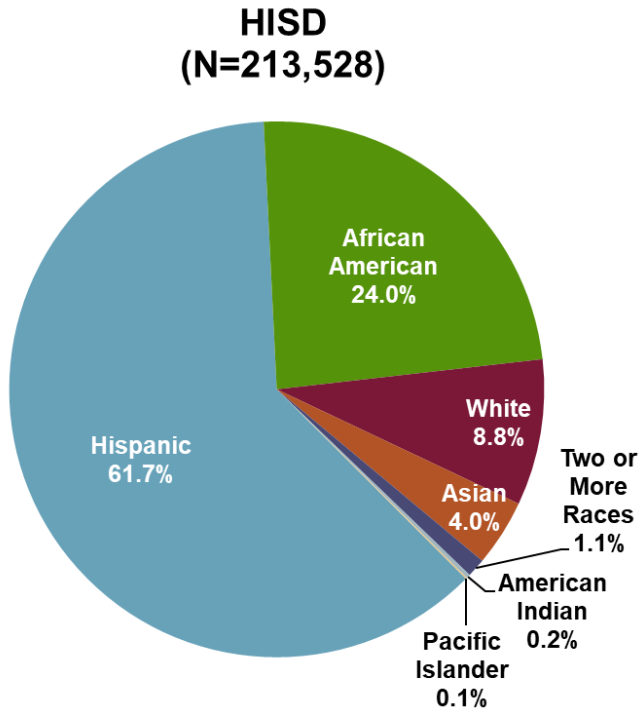
Changes to the Texas Academic Performance Report

- The TAPR data are presented in two formats:
 - PDF
 - Published in December
 - Contains data required by statute
 - Online
 - Updated as data become available
 - Contains additional data
- The TAPR data are aligned with the new accountability system
 - STAAR data are presented at Approaches, Meets, and Masters performance levels
 - Progress is reported according to Domain 2
 - College, Career, and Military Readiness data are included

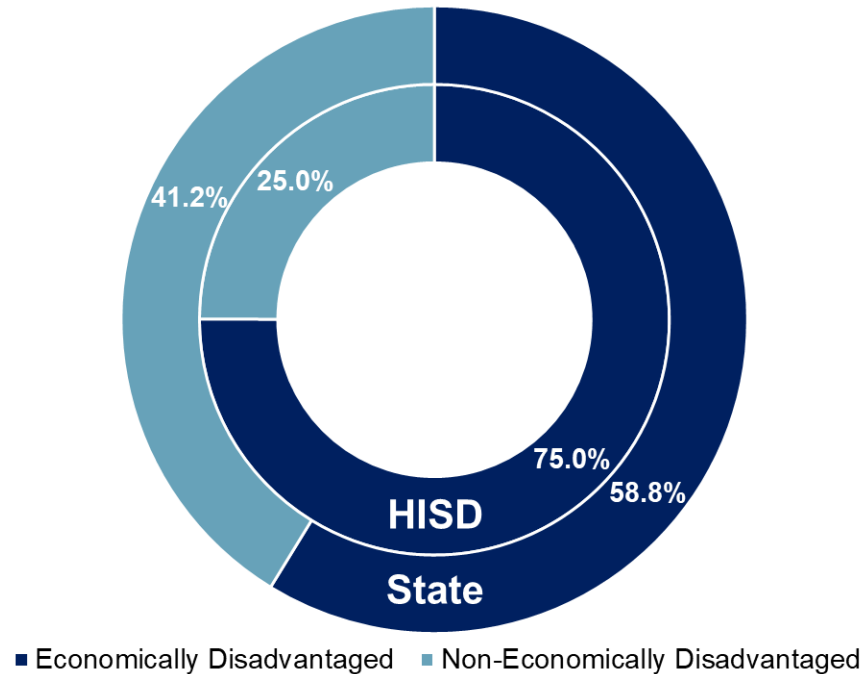
2017–2018 District Enrollment

- **Student Enrollment**
 - 0.9% Decrease in Total Enrollment
 - 0.7% Decrease in African American Enrollment
 - 1.5% Decrease in Hispanic Enrollment
 - 0.4% Increase in White Enrollment
 - 3.6% Increase in Asian Enrollment
 - 3.5% Decrease in Economically Disadvantaged Enrollment
 - 1.8% Decrease in EL Enrollment

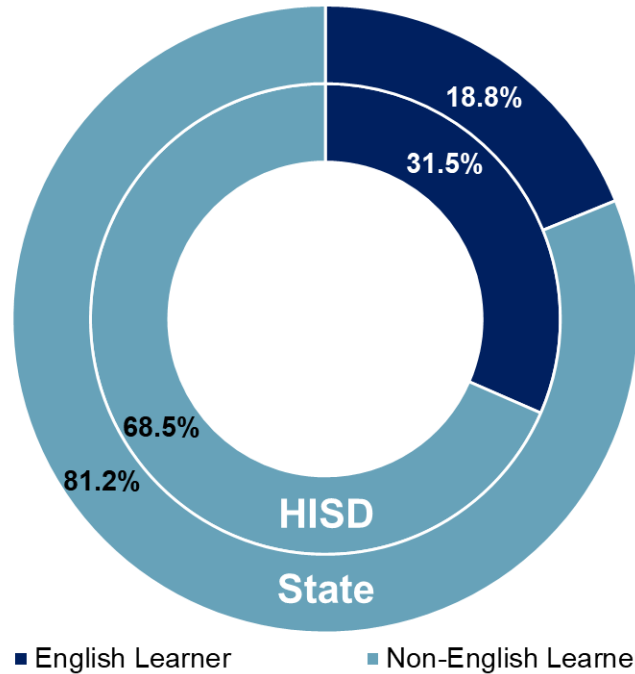
Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity 2017–2018

Enrollment by English Learner Status 2017–2018

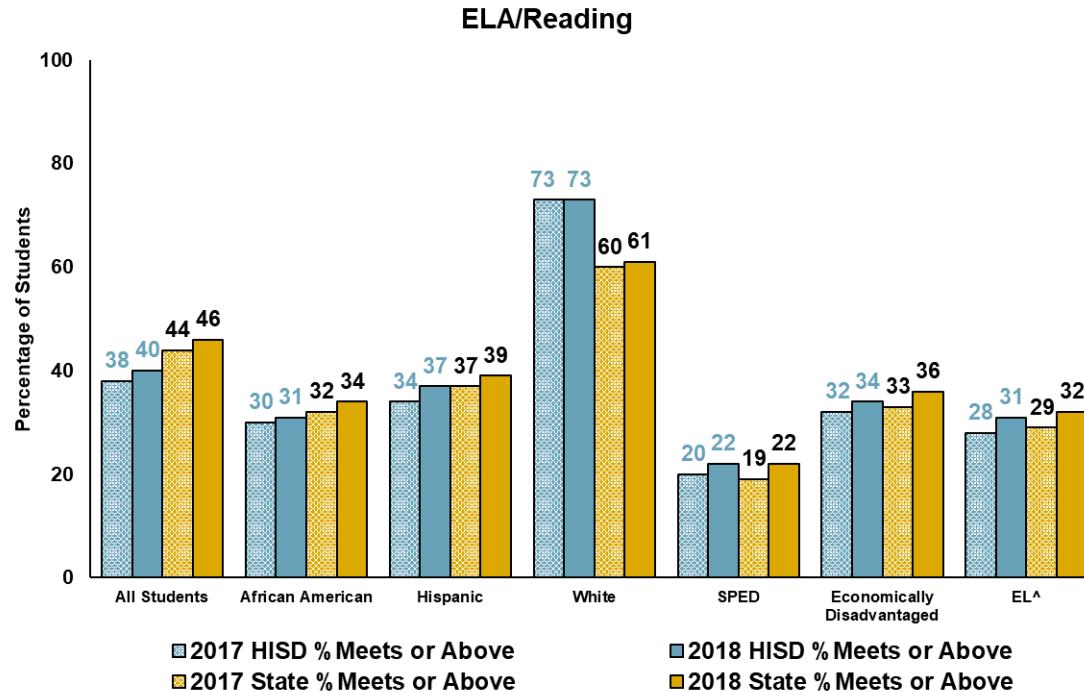

STAAR

- **ELA/Reading**
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above increased 2% points
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above 6% points lower than the state
- **Mathematics**
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above increased 2% points
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above 5% points lower than the state
- **Writing**
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above increased 2% points
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above 5% points lower than the state
- **Science**
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above decreased 1% points
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above 10% points lower than the state
- **Social Studies**
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above increased 3% points
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above 8% points lower than the state
- **All Subjects**
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above increased 2% points
 - District percentage of students at Meets or Above 6% points lower than the state

HISD and State STAAR ELA/Reading Percentage at Meets or Above All Grades, 2017 and 2018



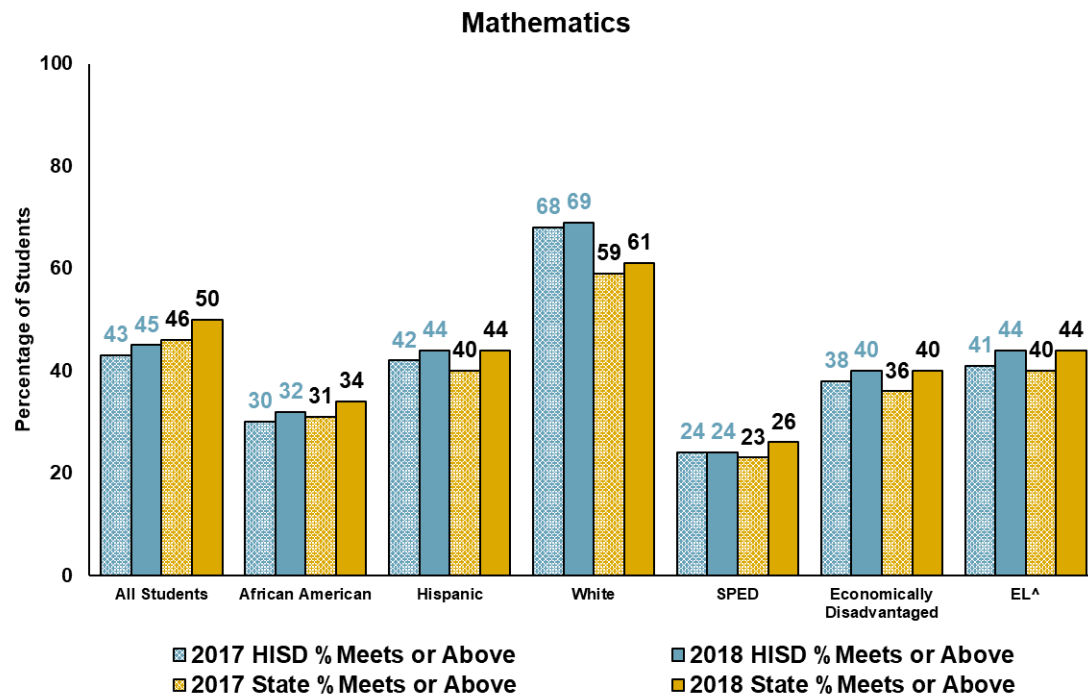

Percentage at Meets or Above

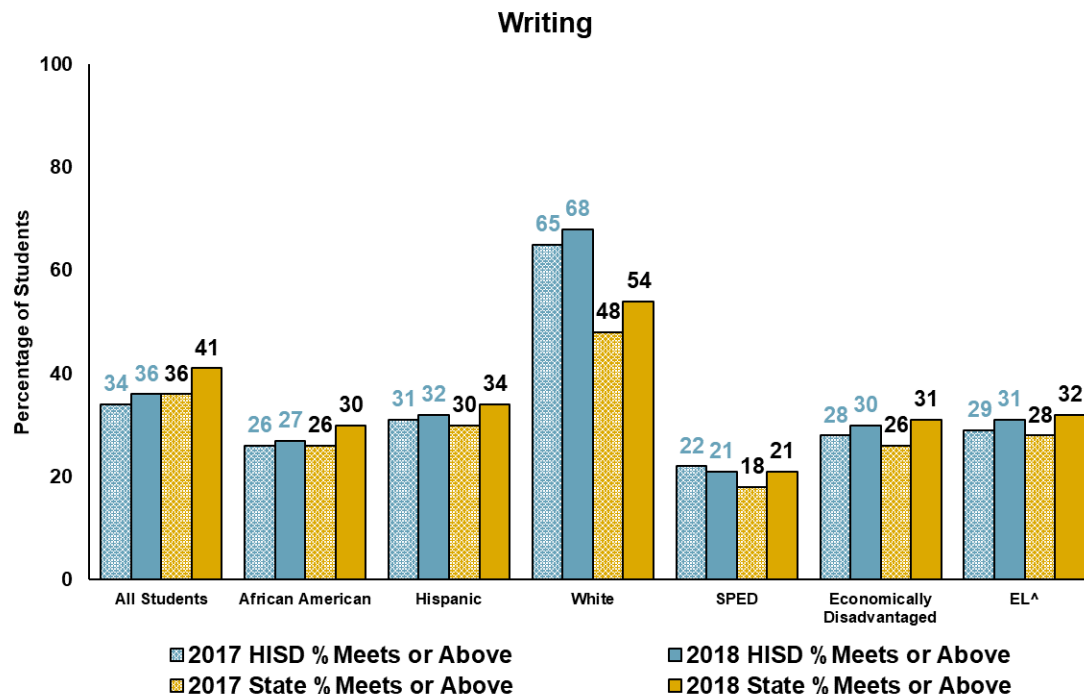

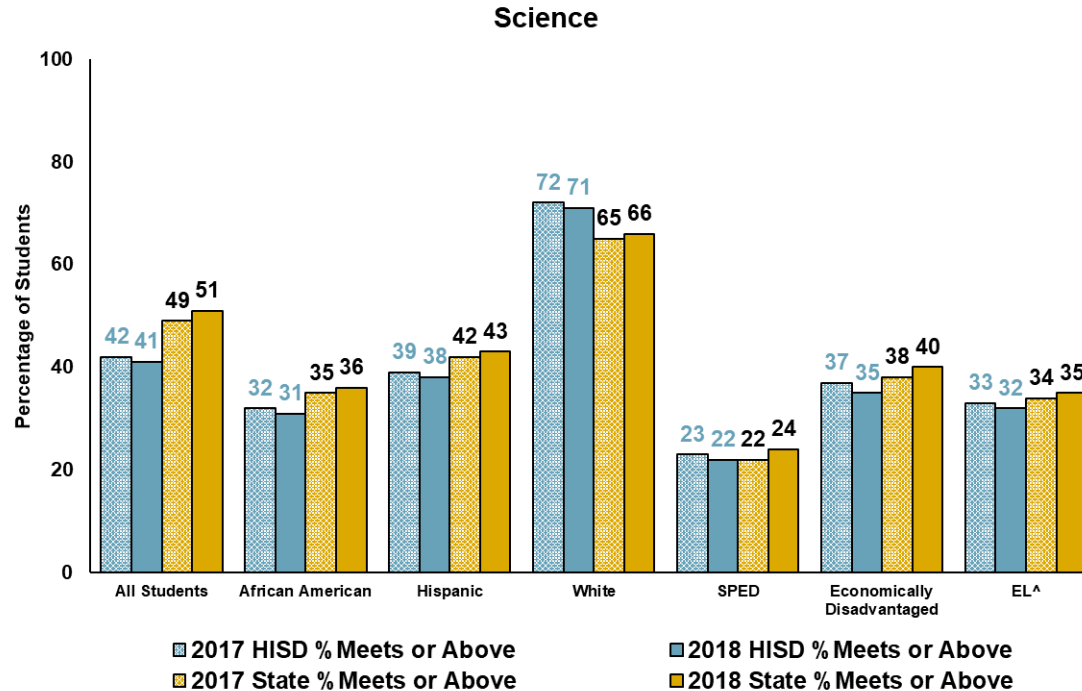
HISD and State STAAR Writing Percentage at Meets or Above All Grades, 2017 and 2018

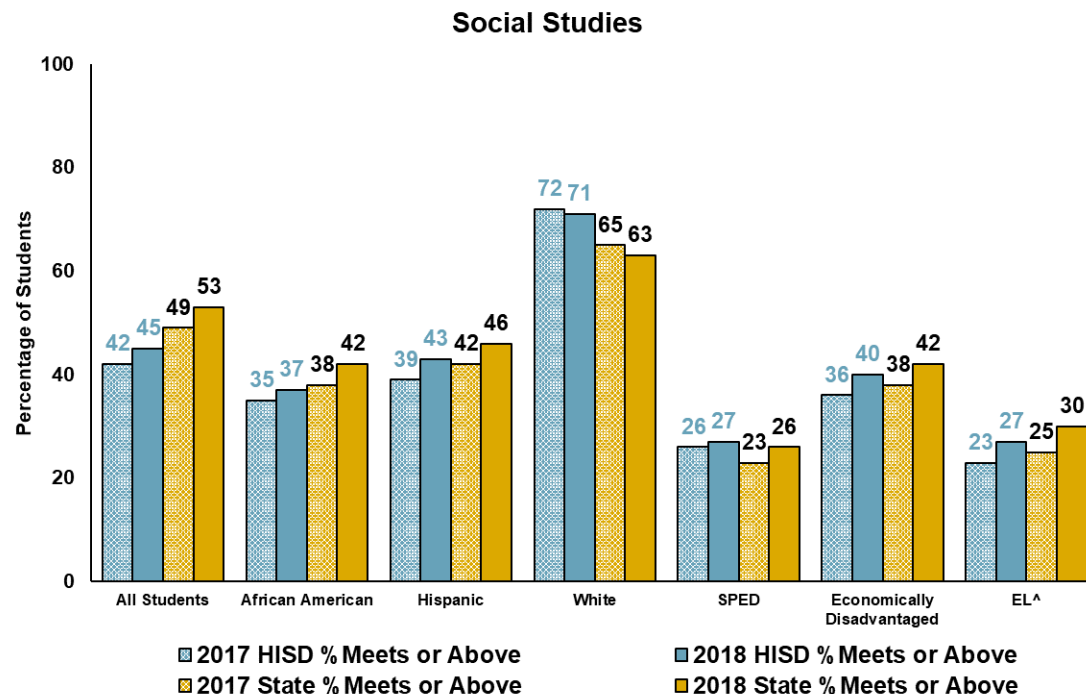
HISD and State STAAR Science Percentage at Meets or Above All Grades, 2017 and 2018

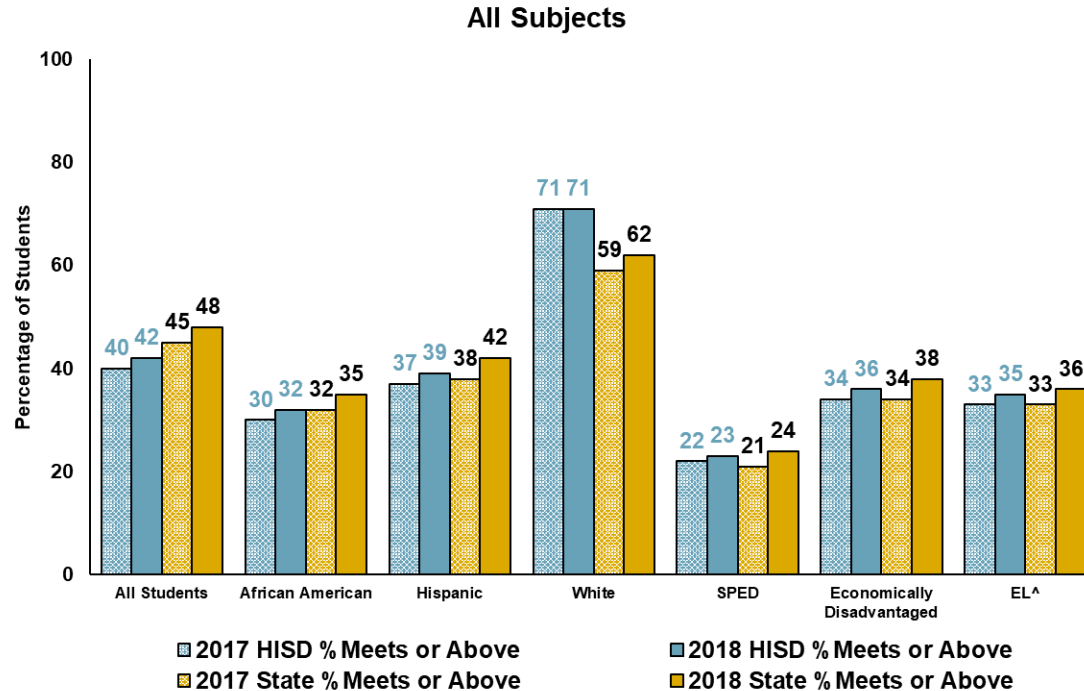
HISD and State STAAR Social Studies Percentage at Meets or Above All Grades, 2017 and 2018

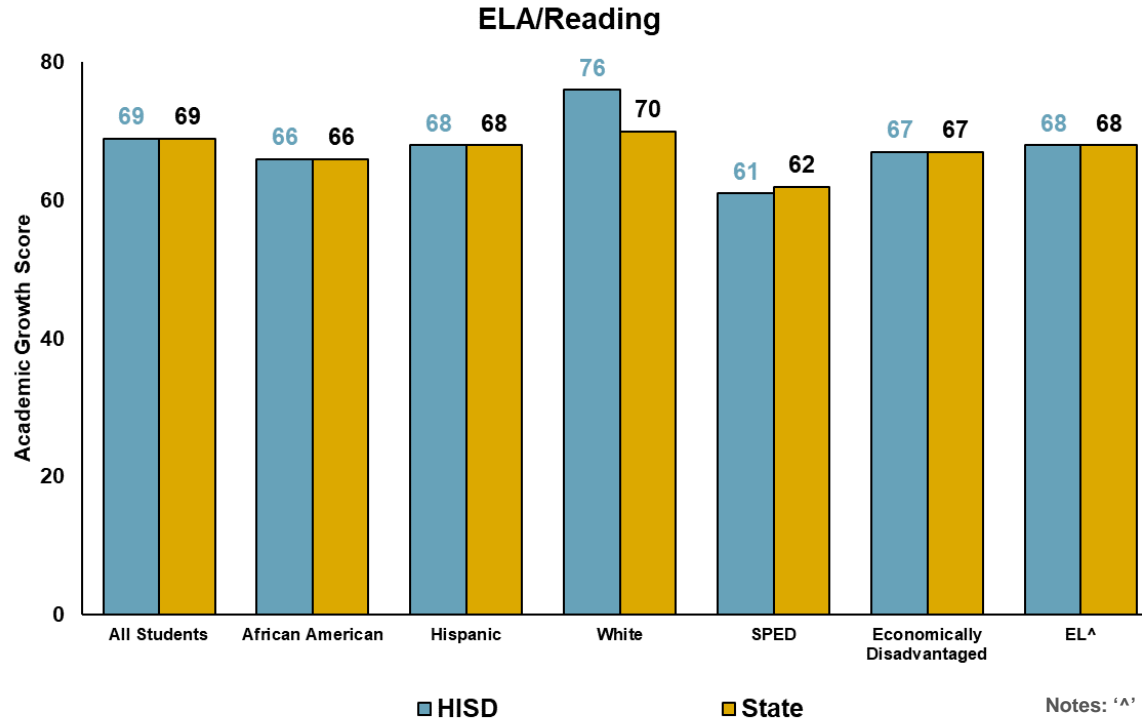
HISD and State STAAR All Subjects Percentage at Meets or Above All Grades, 2017 and 2018

HISD and State STAAR ELA/Reading School Progress Domain – Academic Growth Score All Grades, 2018



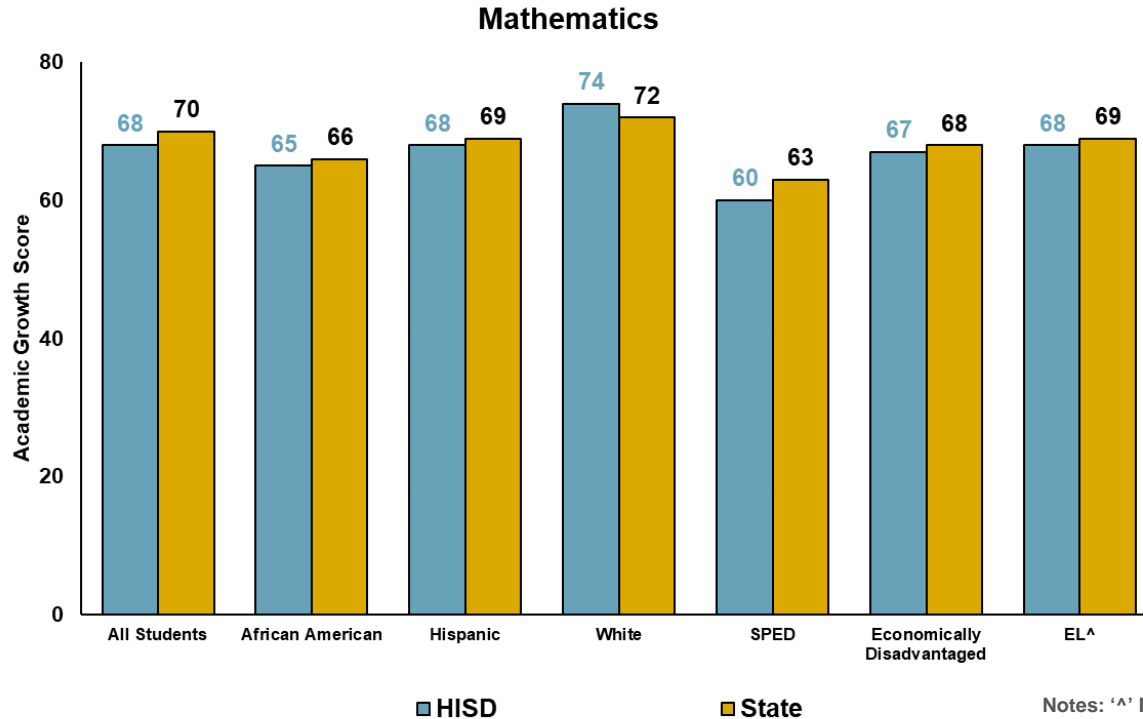

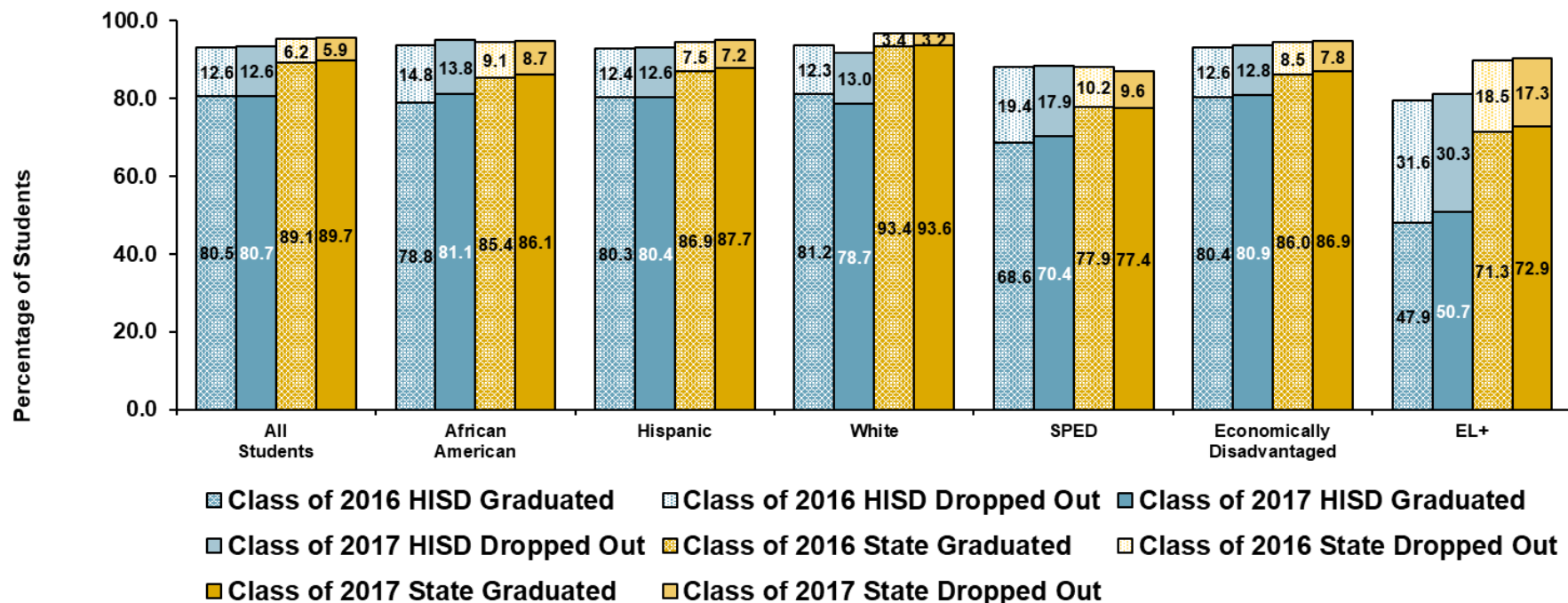

Graduation and Dropout

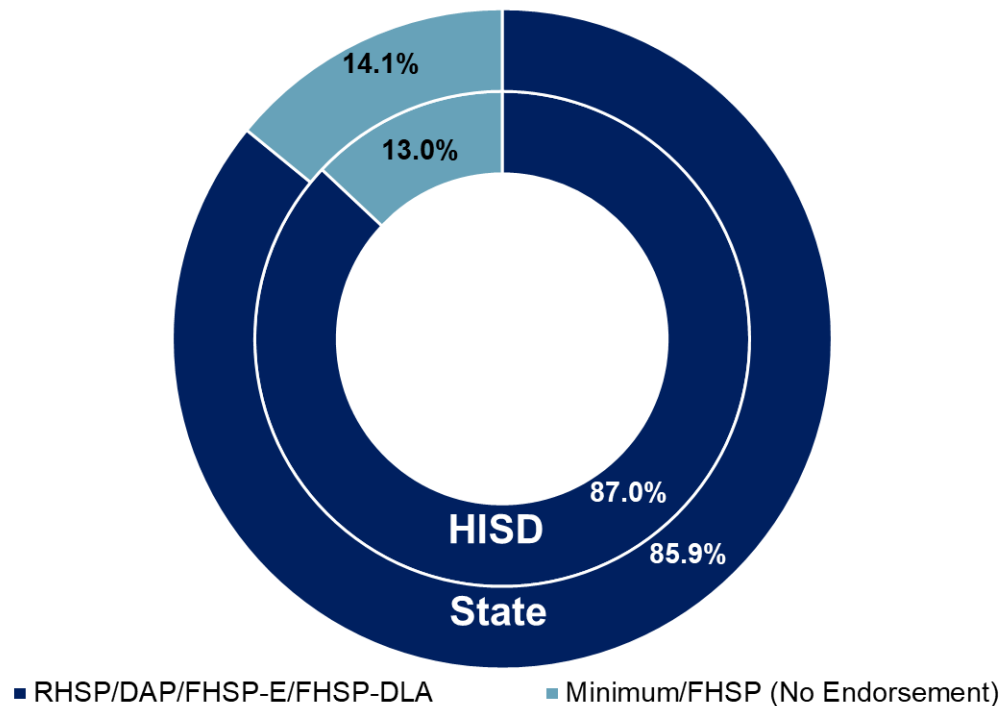
- **2017 4-Year Longitudinal Graduation Rate**
 - District rate increased 0.2% points
 - District rate lower than the state by 9.0% points
 - District rate increased for African American, Hispanic, Special Education, Economically Disadvantaged, and English Learner students but decreased for White students
- **2017 4-Year Longitudinal Dropout Rate, Grades 9–12**
 - District rate stayed the same
 - District rate higher than the state by 6.7% points

AP/IB

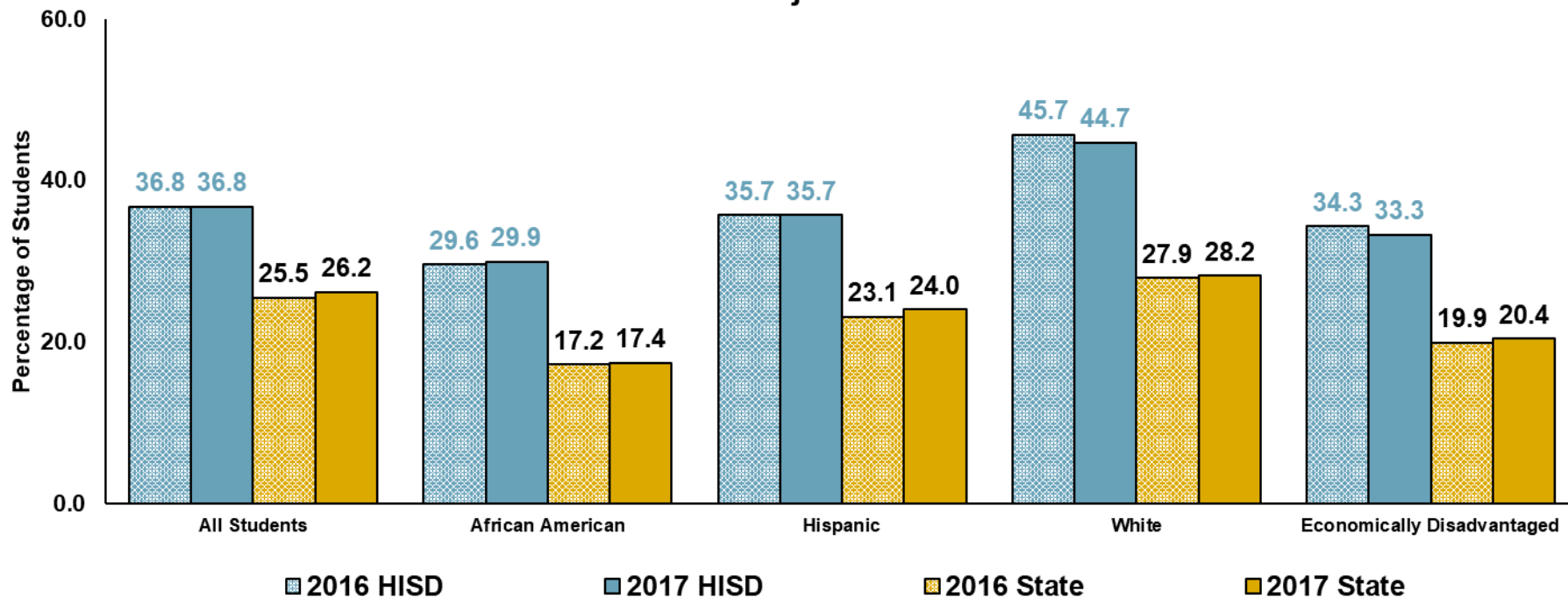
- **2017 AP/IB Examination Participation Rates**
 - District participation rate stayed the same
 - District participation rate 10.6% points higher than the state
 - District participation rate increased for African American and stayed the same for Hispanic students
- **2017 AP/IB Examination Performance Results**
 - District percentage of testers meeting criterion increased 0.7% points
 - District rate 11.2% points lower than the state

All Subjects

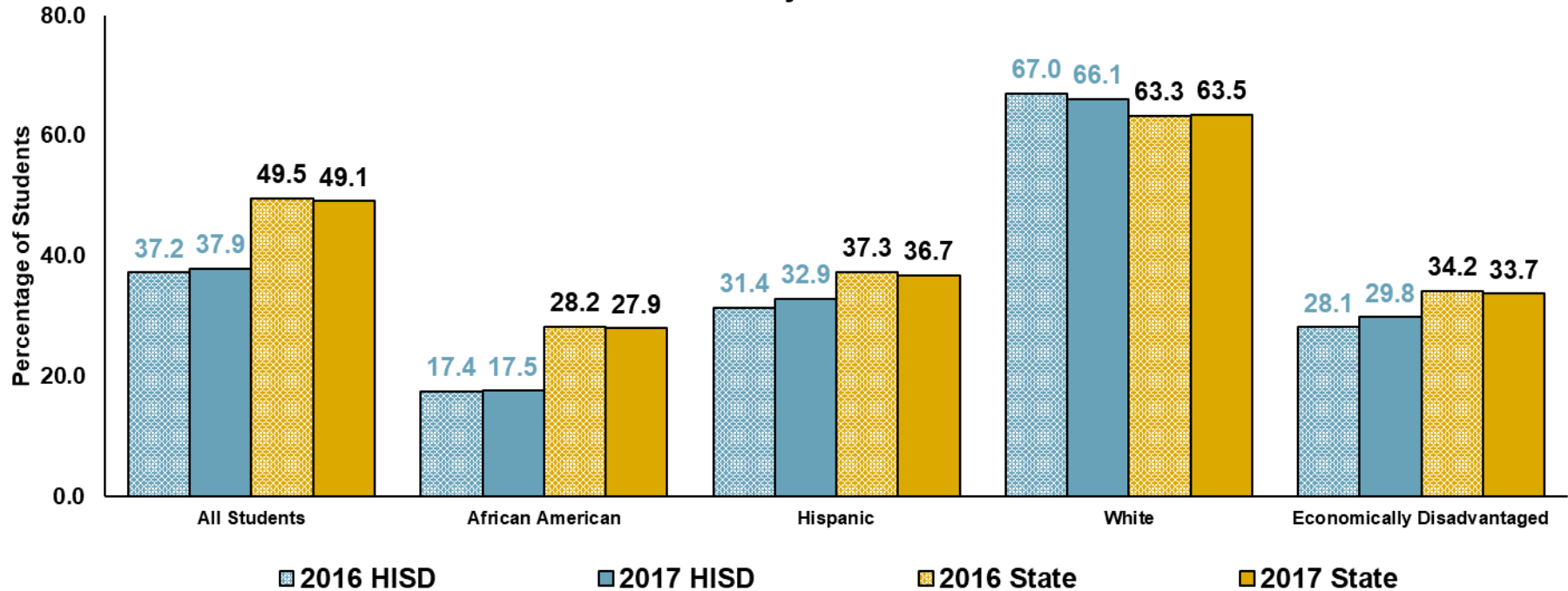

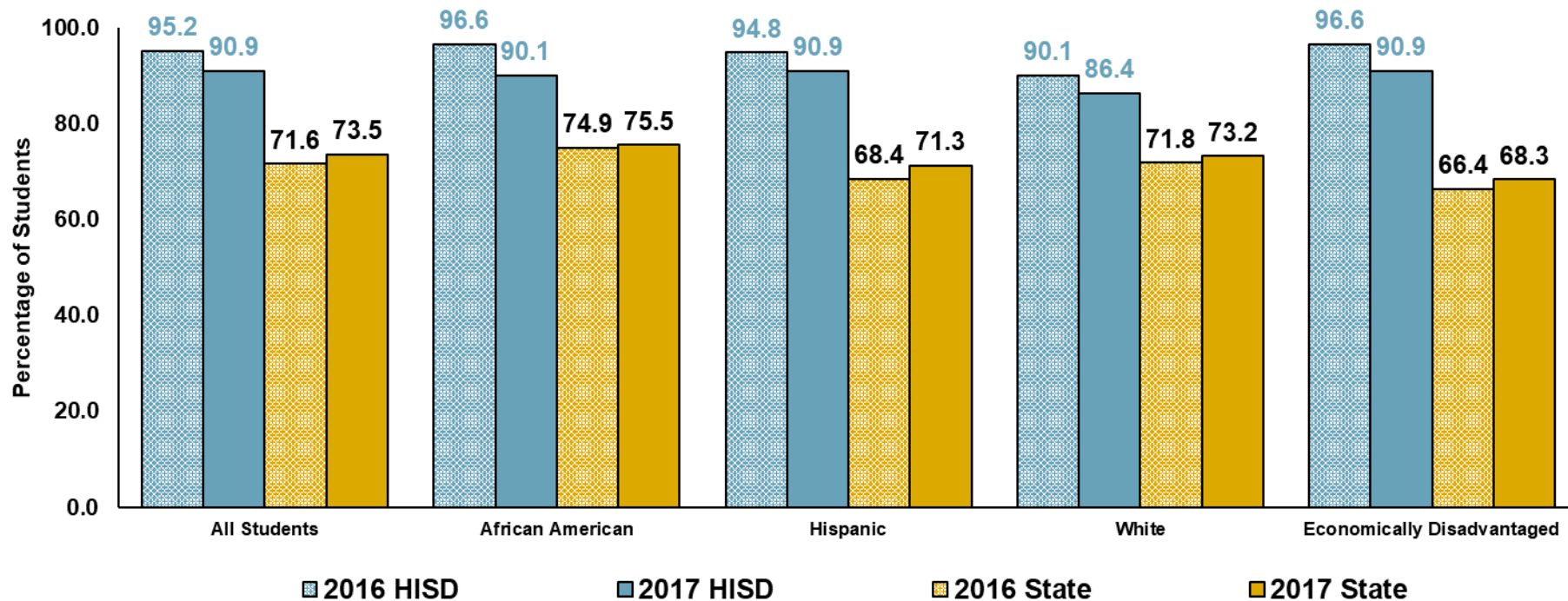
2017–2018 District Performance

SAT/ACT

- **2017 SAT/ACT Participation**
 - District participation rate decreased 4.3% points
 - District participation rate 17.4% points higher than the state
- **2017 Average SAT Scores**
 - SAT was redesigned in March 2016, and scores from the old test and new test cannot be compared
 - District scores lower than state scores
- **2017 Average ACT Scores**
 - District average composite score increased 0.8 points
 - District average composite score 1.6 points higher than the state

HISD and State SAT/ACT Participation Percentage Tested

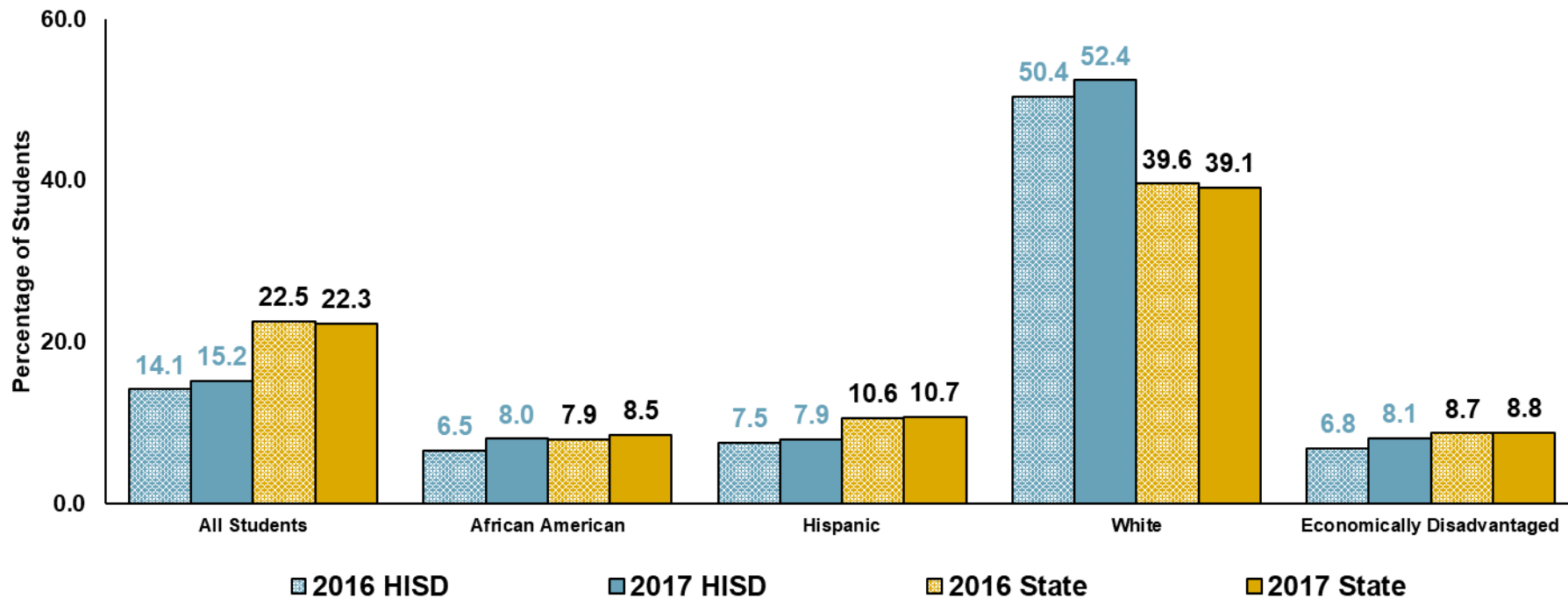
Annual Graduates, 2016 and 2017

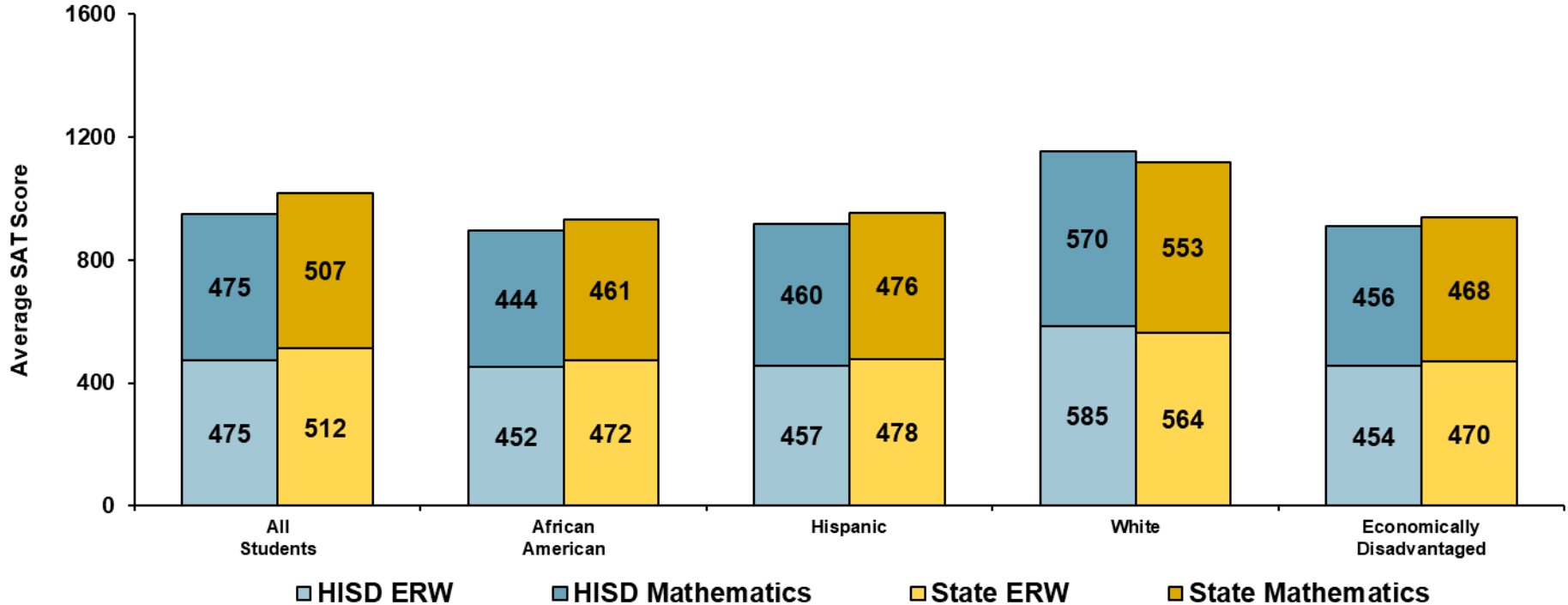

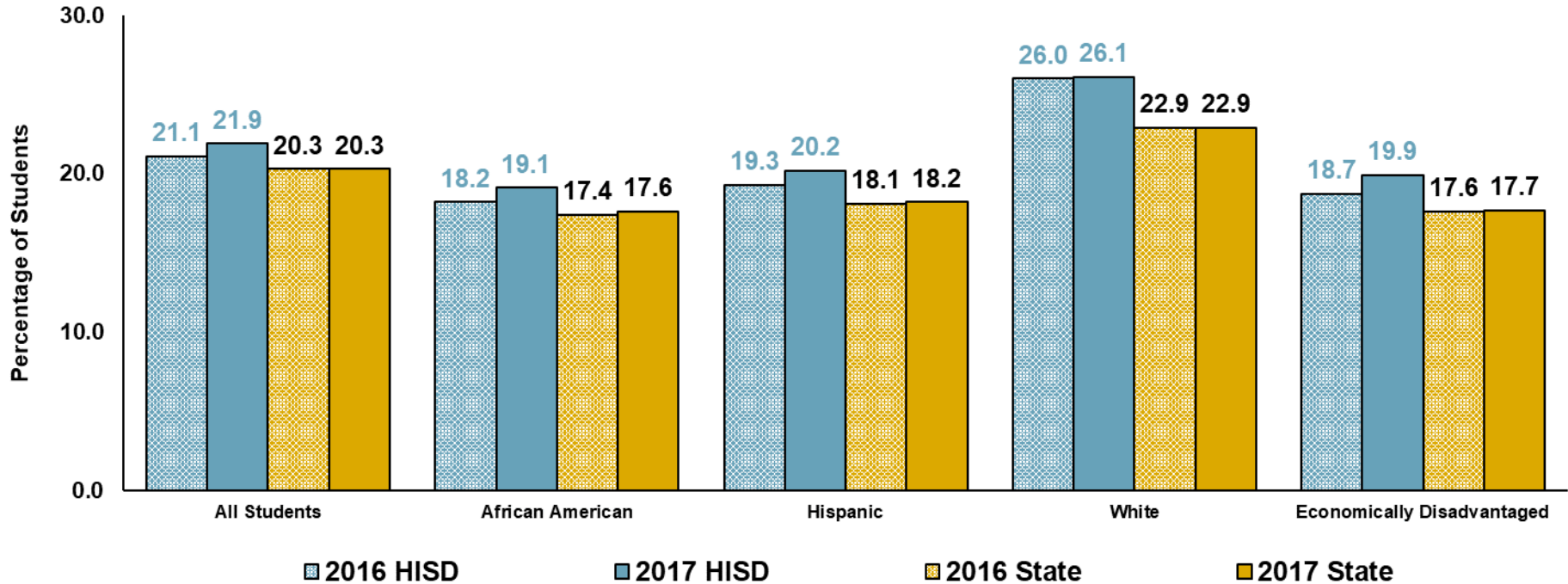

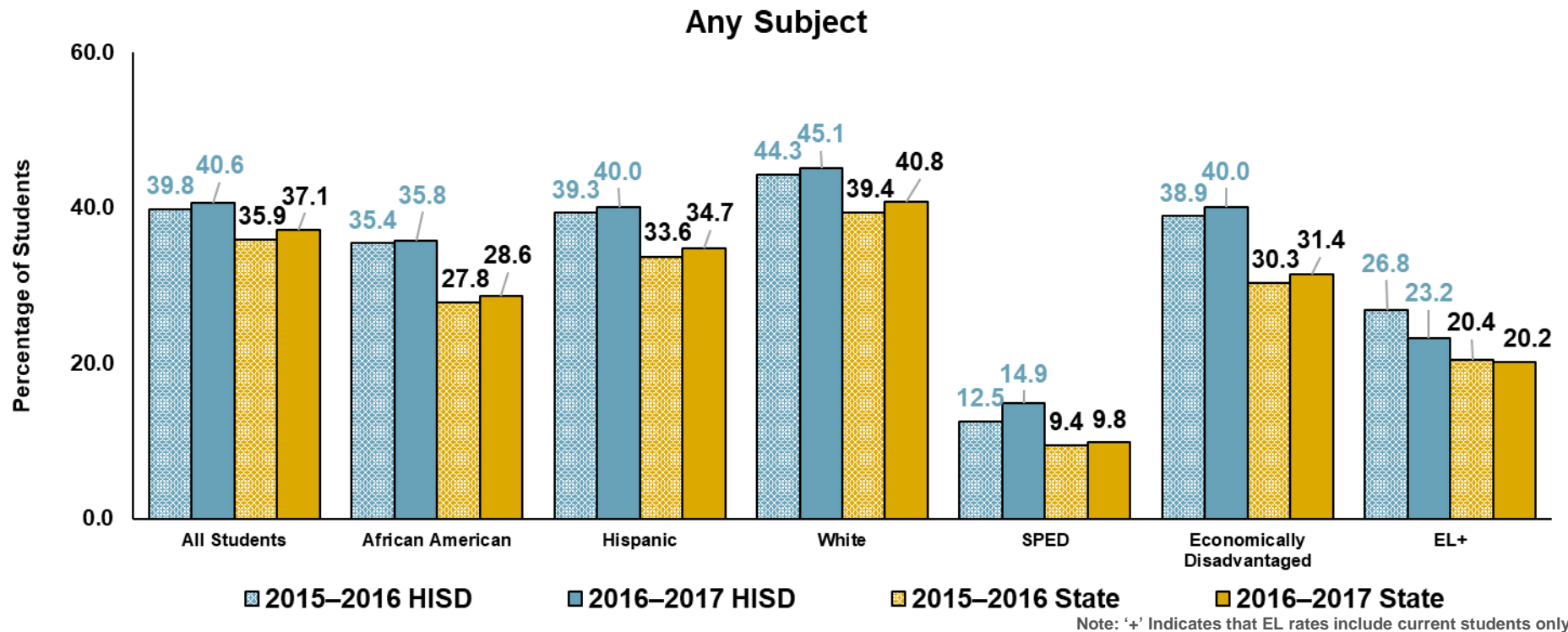
Advanced/Dual Credit Courses

- **2016–2017 Advanced/Dual Credit Course Completion (Grades 9–12)**
 - District completion rate increased 0.8% points
 - District completion rate 3.5% points higher than state

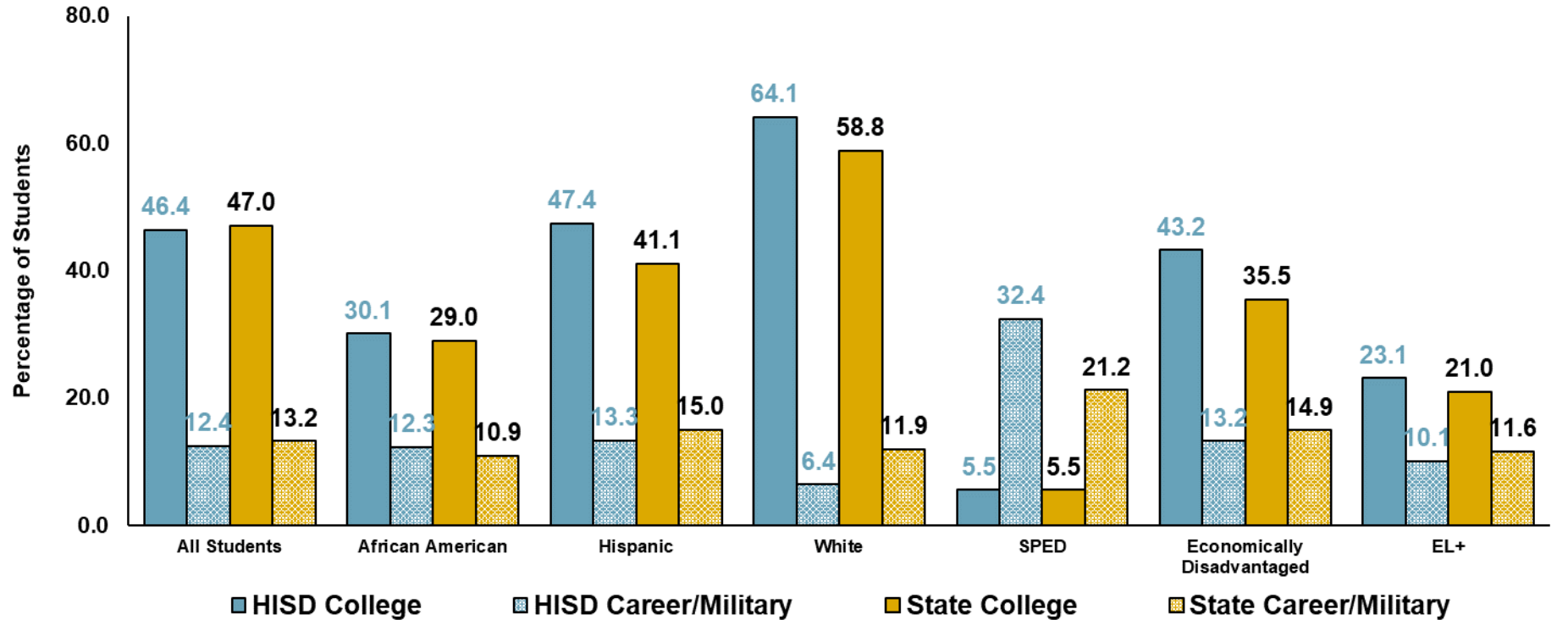
College, Career, and Military Ready (CCMR)

- **2017 College-Ready**
 - District percentage of college-ready students 0.6% points lower than the state
 - District percentage of college-ready African American, Hispanic, White, Economically Disadvantaged, and English Learner students higher than the state
- **2017 Career/Military Ready**
 - District percentage of career/military-ready students 0.8% points lower than the state
 - District percentage of career/military-ready African American and Special Education students higher than the state
- **2017 College, Career, and Military Ready**
 - District percentage of college, career, and military ready African American, Hispanic, White, Special Education, Economically Disadvantaged, and English Learner students higher than the state

Annual Graduates, 2017

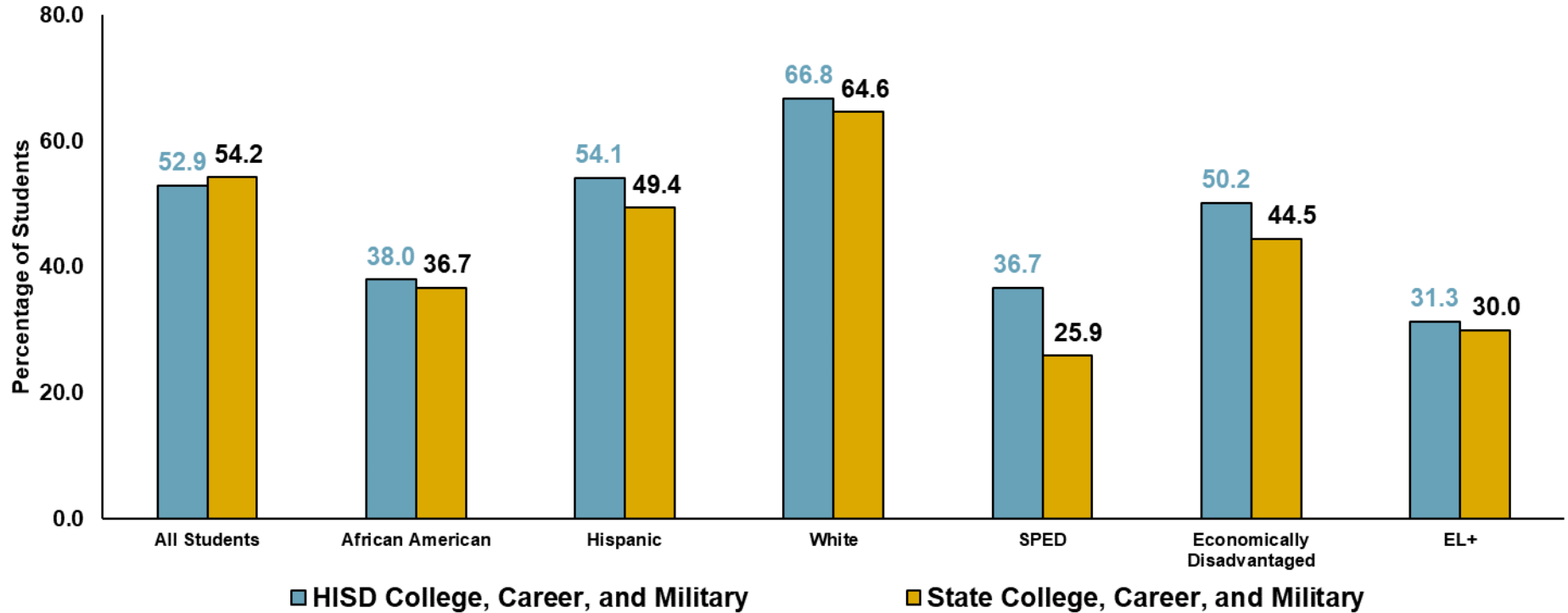

Annual Graduates, 2017



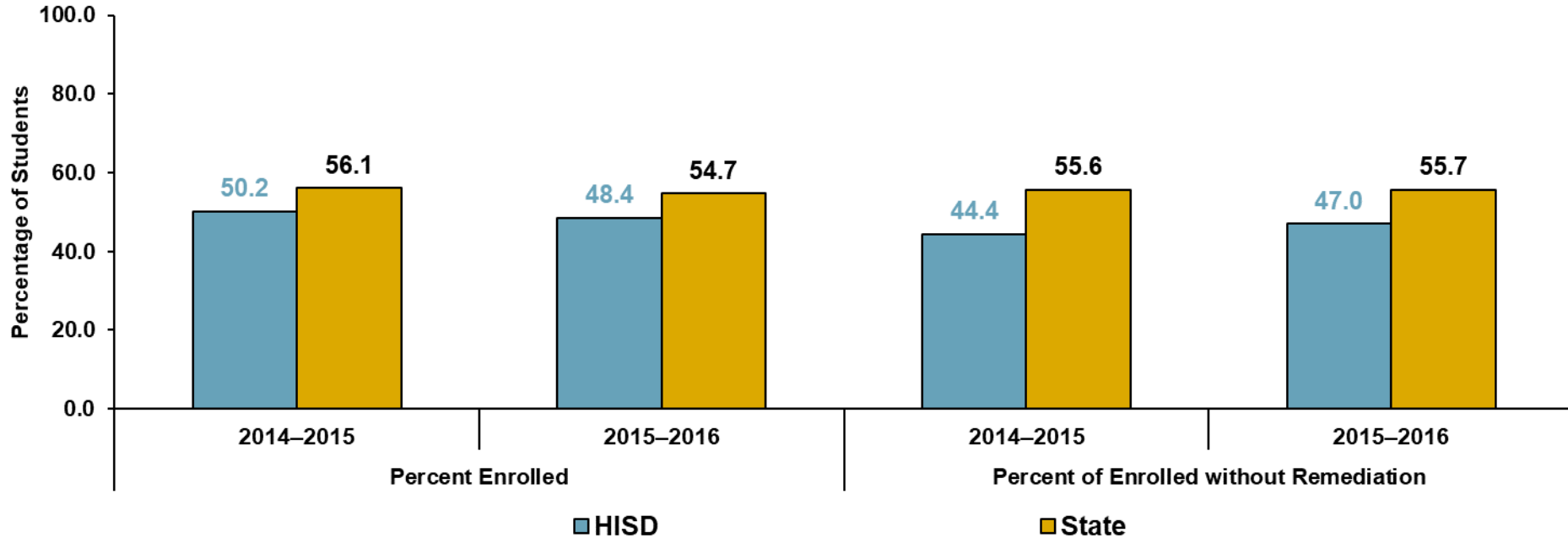

2017–2018 District Performance

Enrollment in Higher Education

- **2015–2016 Graduate Enrollment in TX Institution of Higher Education**
 - District enrollment decreased 1.8% points
 - District enrollment 6.3% points lower than state
- **2015–2016 Graduate Enrollment in TX Institution of Higher Education (without Remediation)**
 - District enrollment increased 2.6% points
 - District enrollment 8.7% points lower than state

HISD and State Graduates in Texas Higher Education 2014–2015 and 2015–2016



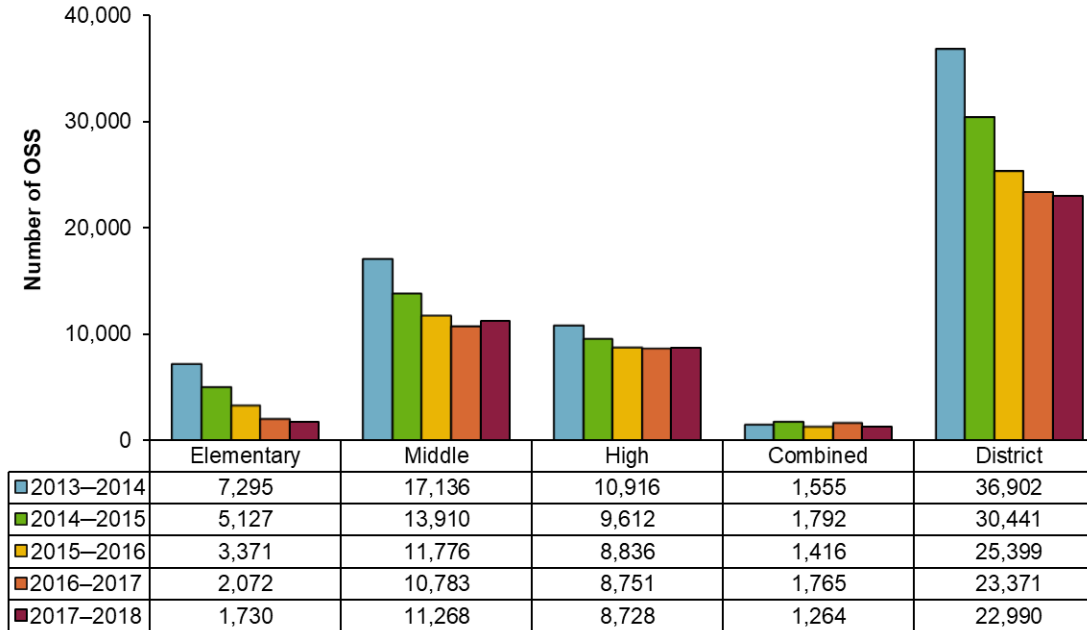

Discipline

- **Out-of-School Suspensions**
 - Number of Out-of-School Suspensions increased only at the Middle School level
- **Weapon Possessions**
 - After a four-year low in 2016–2017, number of incidents of students using or possessing an illegal weapon increased across all school levels

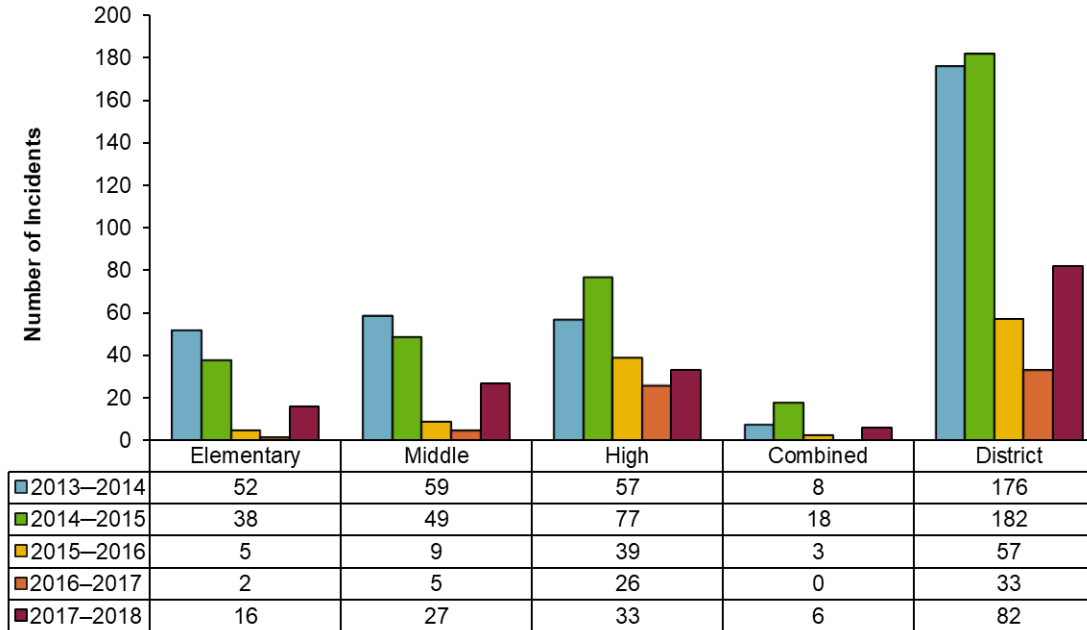
HISD Out-of-School Suspensions 2013–2014 through 2017–2018

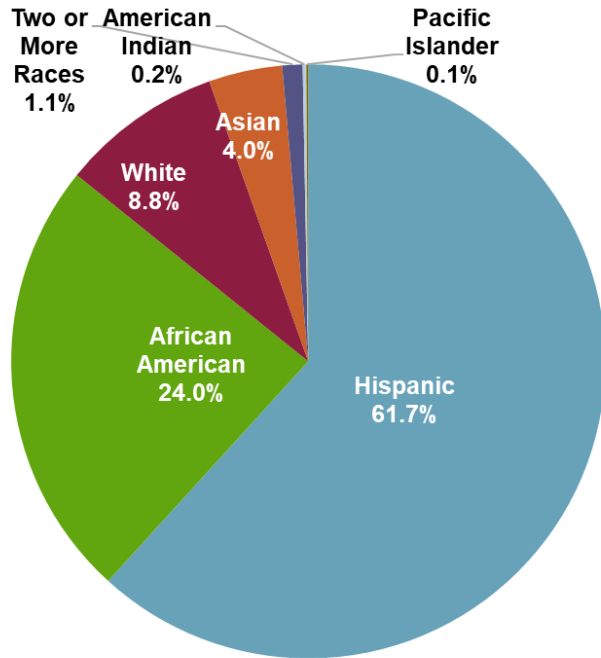

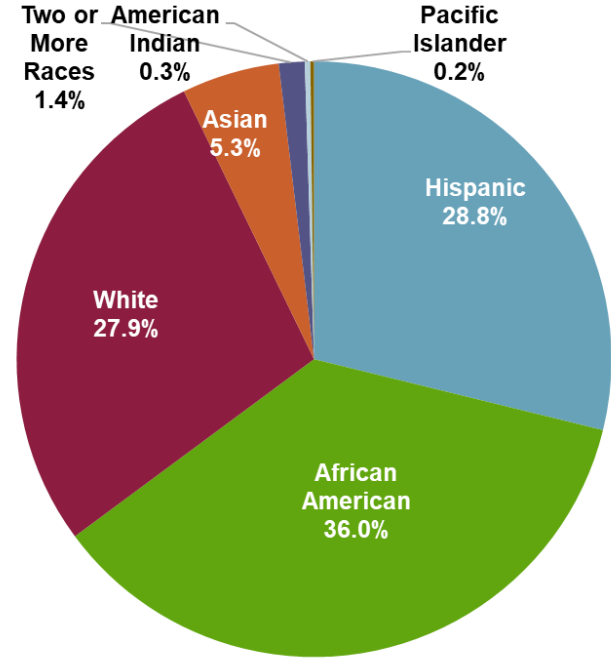
Staff

- **Proportion of Student Population and Teachers by Race/Ethnicity**
 - Hispanic teachers are under-represented compared to student population
- **Teaching Staff by Years of Experience**
 - District proportion of teachers with 1–5 years of experience increased 0.5% points
 - District proportion of teachers with 6–10 years of experience decreased 1.2% points
 - District proportion of teachers with 1–5 years of experience 4.1% points higher than the state
- **Average Teaching Staff Salaries**
 - District average teacher salaries higher than the state across all years of experience categories

Student Population and Teaching Staff by Race/Ethnicity 2017–2018

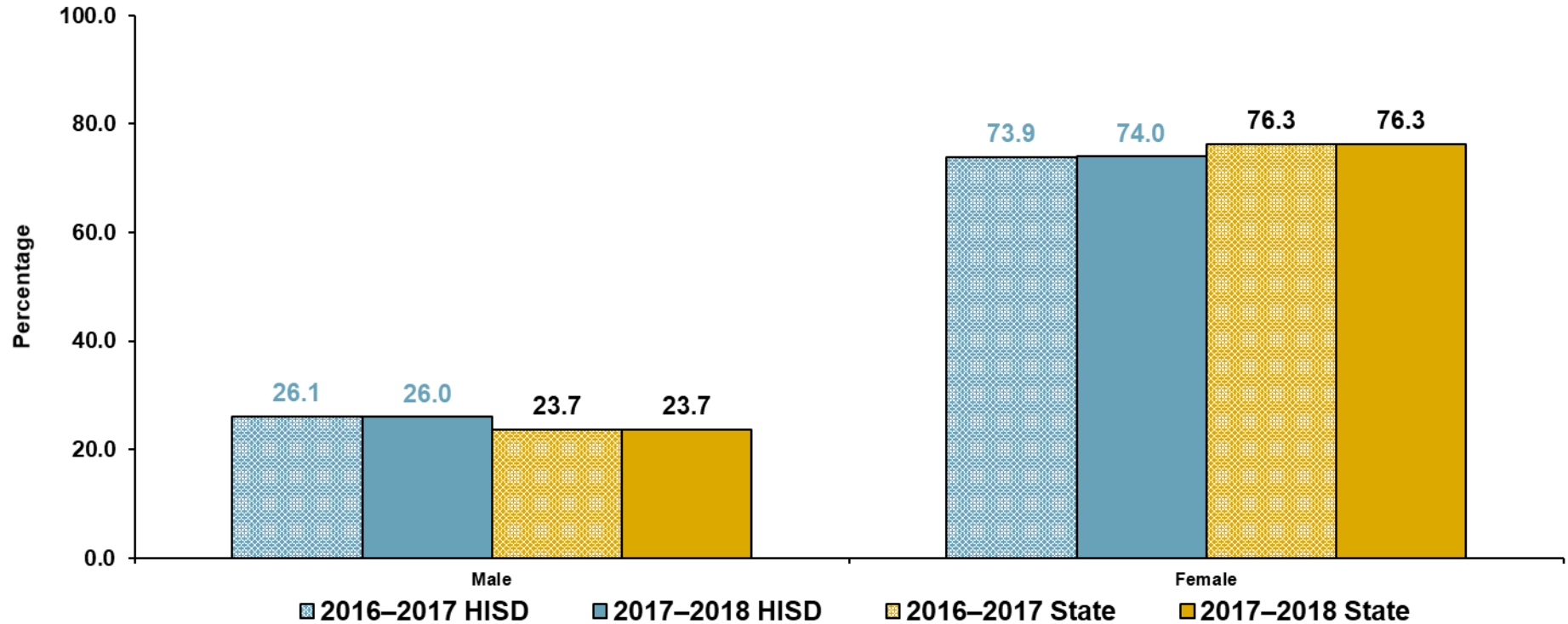

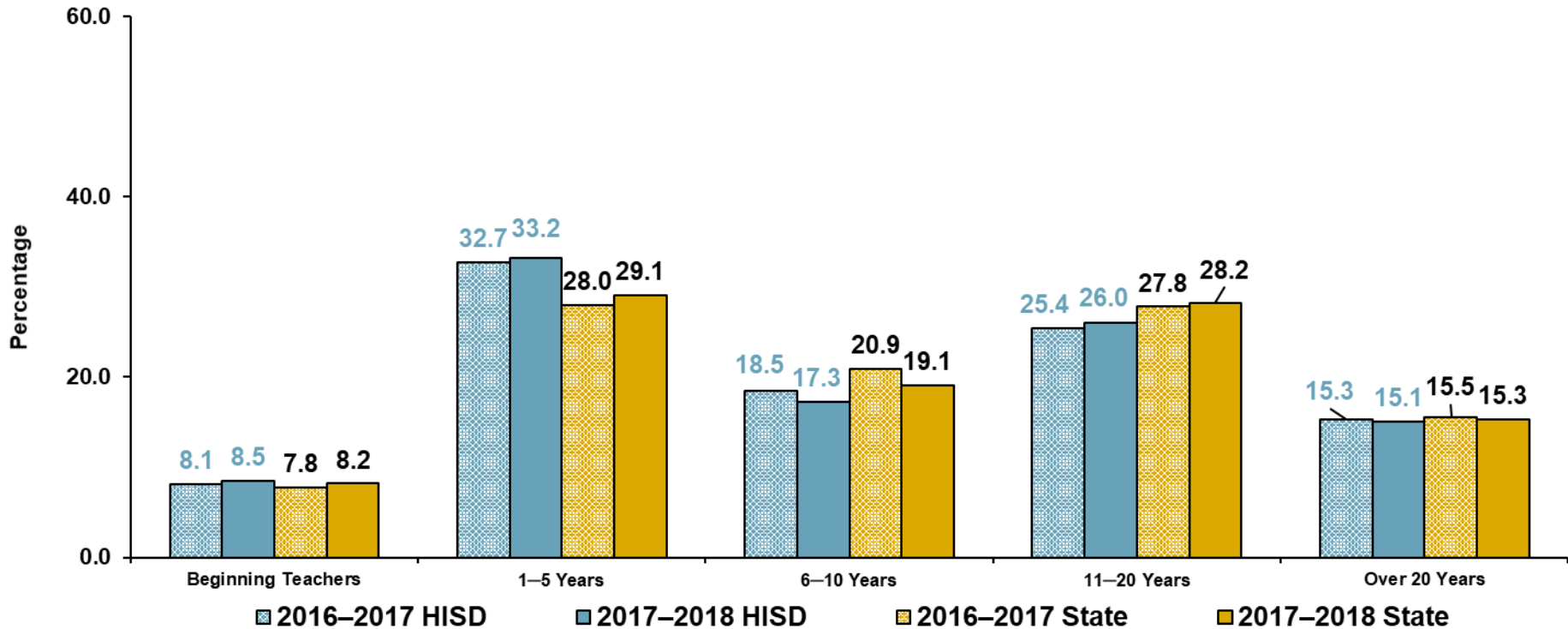

Teaching Staff by Gender 2016–2017 and 2017–2018

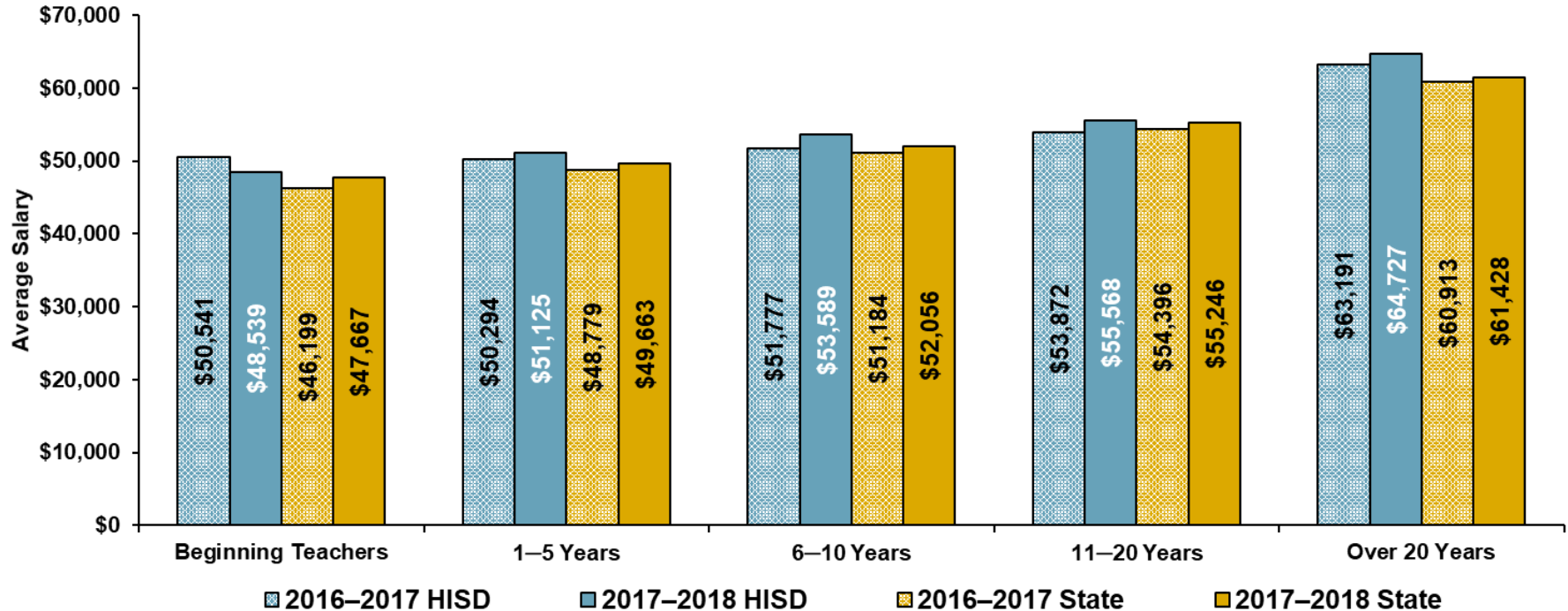


Teaching Staff by Years of Experience

 - Grades 1–5 class size **below** state average
 - Secondary average class size **decreased** for Math
 - All Secondary average class sizes **above** state average for ELA, Foreign Languages, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies
