EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Welcome to the revised and expanded **Houston Independent School District (HISD) Family and Community Engagement (FACE) 2019 Community Resource Guide**. Its primary intended audiences are administrators and teachers in HISD and the parents, guardians, families, and communities they serve.

Structure and Organization

In its sixth edition, the **2019 Community Resource Guide** now includes 47 topics and 1,160 profiles. The profiles encompass 530 unique organizations. A profile is the total description of an entry. An entry is an organization and its total profile under a given topic. A topic is the total collection of profiles for a specific area of interest. The **Guide** consistently uses 15 headings as prompts for information. A heading is a specific question of interest. Each heading is repeated across all entries and within all topics.

Methods Used

In identifying possible topics and profiles for this new, revised edition of the **Guide**, HISD FACE staff members:

- 1. Used service providers' websites as the primary information resource.
- 2. Consulted with peers in other departments for input and insights about service providers.
- 3. Sent emails with questions to selected organizations for which there were gaps in information.
- 4. Made phone calls to selected organizations for which there were also gaps in information.
- 5. Reviewed successive drafts to assess quality, completeness, and ease of use.
- 6. Included a **Product Evaluation Form** for feedback from schools, families, and other users.
