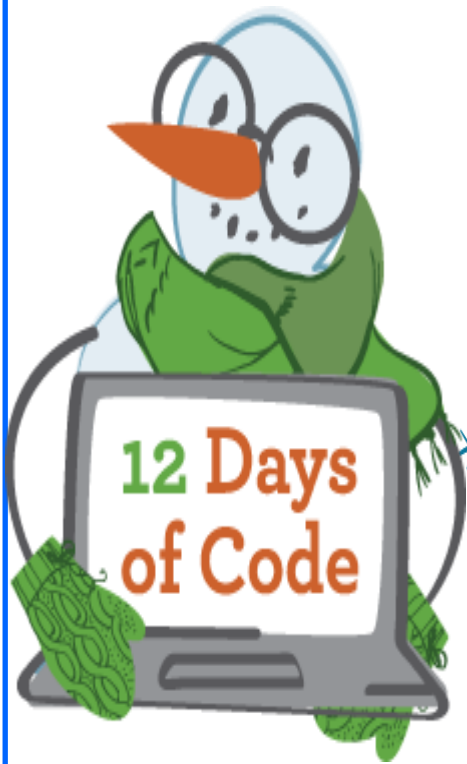
Winter Break
