What's Happening at HAIS the week of March 27, 2017

HOUSTON ACADEMY

In Science, Technology, and Math this week:

Biology students will identify and investigate the role of enzymes in the body systems; describe the role of internal feedback mechanisms in the maintenance of homeostasis

Algebra students in Algebra II will finish an in-depth unit on analysis of polynomials; students in Algebra I will continue to review and assess on quadratics in standard, vertex, and factored form.

Chemistry students will quiz on Energy forms and calculations involving specific heat, Study of Calorimetry to calculate the heat of a chemical process.

In Geometry, students will be tested over chapter 7, Right Triangle Trigonometry, and will construct a mathematical analysis of voting methods.

In Algebra II, students will solve quadratic and square root equations.

In Statistics, students will begin reviewing for the AP test, starting with Unit 1, Understanding Data.

In College Algebra, students will find the zeros of polynomial functions and study the end behavior of rational functions.

Geometry students will use the sine and cosine ratios.

Pre-Calculus students will express products as sums and sums as products.

AP Calculus students will calculate, interpret, and apply integrals.

Here's What's Happening in the Humanities this week:

English 1 students will read Romeo and Juliet, a tragedy written by William Shakespeare and they will create sonnets that summarize selected excerpts.

AP Human Geography students will review for the AP Exam through Practice Exams, Peer Review of FRQs, and Tips for Tackling Multiple Choice.

AP World History We will be moving rapidly through WWI, the Russian Revolutions, WWII, the Cold War and Decolonization in our home stretch. Students should be studying daily and checking the HUB for all assignments. Also, it is highly recommended students get a copy of "5 Steps to a 5" by April 7, we will be using it in class to prepare for the AP World History Exam during our month long review period.


AP United States History- Dual Credit students will identify, evaluate, and analyze US participation in the Cold War.
