Questions, Comments, Concerns

Principal Bellard opened the meeting at 3:06pm and thanked the committee members for their attendance and participation.

Principal Bellard stated the purpose of the meeting was to share the agenda items and to get the committee's input on each. First item discussed was in addition to the school improvement plan, we are required by district to complete a targeted improvement plan (TIP) which is the same as the one required by the state when a school fails to meet state accountability. It is not a state requirement for us because we met state accountability, but with a minimal score. The next item discussed was PEIMS Snapshot, which is today, Friday, October 29, 2021. This day determines the final student enrollment which is 387 (projected 445). We are below projection but will not have to make additional budget adjustments because we closed teacher positions that were not needed due to low enrollment. The final budget is determined by student enrollment and other factors such as student groups (i.e., bilingual, economically disadvantaged, gifted/talented, attendance, etc.). The PEIMS Data is used to determine both our 2021-2022 operating budget and our state achievement accountability rating. The final budget totals will be confirmed now that we have reached the PEIMS Snapshot date. We will now make decisions about hiring hourly interventionists and offering extended day tutorials to address students' academic needs.

Ms. Herbert and Mr. Farinas expressed concerns about the preliminary snapshot data. Mr. Farinas expressed that the campus scores are in line with the district's average. I reminded the committee that information gained from the planned November 2, 2021, Grades 3-5 Reading and Math Snapshots Data Dig PLCs will be used to inform and drive instructional practices needed to address the deficiencies in student performance. We will also have Sheltered Instruction PLCs on November 2, 2021, for all other grade levels and contents.

Finally, we discussed the vacant classroom teacher position on the committee. There is no need to fill the position due to the required 2/3 classroom teacher membership is currently fulfilled.

There were no other topics discussed. Principal Bellard thanked the committee and adjourned the meeting at 3:42pm.
