Positions have closed as a result of:

- Not meeting enrollment projection and low student attendance (\$116,000 give back due to enrollment; \$113,000 handout with all details passed out)
- Attendance - teachers reach out to parents, classroom incentive/competition, parent idea; parent; incentive get admin together and make them aware of concerns/students with tardies/absences

Curriculum

- DLA - Data - DLA data passed out for Math, Reading, Writing and Science
- STAAR Intervention Plan - Team lead & teachers will/are making plans
- After School tutorials will begin on Monday, January 22, 2018
