- Budget
  - \$210 per student is currently expected to be lost next school year. More details at the next SDMC meeting.
  - Transportation bus money may be affected for extracurriculars such as soccer and engineering.
- Student Fees
  - Cell phones/headphones will be enforced throughout the school including passing periods.
  - Extracurricular activities and groups will need to begin to pay dues associated for maintenance of their club such as transportations, uniforms.
  - Clubs and Organizations will be asked to send home a form listing all fees. If students are unable to pay fees, advisory teachers/PTO will be notified to see if they are able to assist.
  - SchoolPay will be updated to reflect student dues for all grade levels. Dues will be increased to \$300 per students.
  - Challenge will not collect textbook fees as long as the district continues to pay for them.
  - \$5 fee for any student wishing to take the TSI test after the initial time as 9th graders.

- Safety
  - Radios were purchased last school year for every classroom as a safety measure for the school
  - Intercom was discussed to be added to the school, pending information about cost from the district.
  - The building was re-keyed last school year.
  - Crime Stoppers training was discussed and more information will be presented next SDMC meeting.
  - 4:45pm will be the new school closure time. Tutorials will continue to end at 4:35pm Monday-Friday.
