 1. 2018-2019 872-894 enrollment
 2. Last year we ended with 802
 3. 832 is our goal
- Budget
 1. Explaining the budget breakdown.
 2. Title I breakdown: 19k is for Boot Camp
 3. A180- Wednesday
 4. HB45- Afterschool Tutorials
 5. ESSER II Funds – Emergency Funds to spend on Interventions for Saturday Tutorials and interventions for our students.
 6. ESSER III Funds – Resources for our students
 7. Payback money if we do not meet our enrollment.
 8. Students- per student allotment, how much we get per student \$3,600.
 9. We were not meeting our 96% of attendance from last year and they are taking the money back.

12. Not allowed to purchase technology for now, but Ms. Z is working on it (PC2?) by November we should know how much tech we will be receiving.
