

Harper's Level Management System

Harper's Level Management System consists of three levels: Level I (The Beginning Level), Level II (The Intermediate Level), and Level III (The Exit Level). Each level gives the student, parent, and staff a clear picture of the progress that the student is making in this Behavior Management Program.

Behavior Management Contract:

All students can earn a total of 350 points per week. This is based on 7 class periods per day with the ability to earn 10 points each class period. It is the goal of the Harper Behavior Management System to assist students in identifying behaviors that impede their progress in school. The Goal is to be consistent in appropriate In-School Behaviors acceptable for Main Stream Education. Consideration for "Exiting" the Harper Program will be made only after a student has completed at least 60 "School Days". Exit ARD meetings will only be scheduled at Semester Intervals.

Level I

A student must earn at least 70% (or 245 out of 350 points) of his/her points per week for at least two weeks (concurrent) in order to advance to Level II. Violations cannot exceed the following:

.Evaluation Time on Level I...(2 Weeks)

- No more than 4 Citations**
- No more than 2 Discipline Cards**
- No more than 1 Bus Report**
- No Unexcused Absences**
- No Leaving Campus**
- No HPD Citations**
- Passing Grades and Classroom Conduct of either "S" or "E"**

Note: failure to meet the minimum requirements in any of these areas will result in starting over at Day 1 of this Level.***

Level II

Evaluation Time on Level II is...(6 Weeks)

A student on Level II must earn at least 80% (or 280 out of 350 points) of his/her points for four weeks (concurrent) and meet the minimum requirements as follows:

- No more than 2 Citations**
- No more than 1 Discipline Card**
- No more than 1 Bus Report**
- No Unexcused Absences**
- No Leaving Campus**
- No HPD Citations**
- Passing grades and classroom conduct of either "S" or "E" *****

Level III

Evaluation Time on Level III is...(8 Weeks)

A student must earn at least 90% (or 315 out of 350 points) of his/her points for 6 weeks (concurrent) and meet the minimum requirements as follows:

- No more than 1 Citation**
- No Discipline Cards**
- No Bus Reports**
- No Unexcused Absences**
- No leaving Campus**
- No HPD Citations**
- Passing Grades and classroom conduct of either "S" or "E."**

Exit Plan: Every student exiting the Harper Program will be required to write an "Exit plan" detailing the following.

1. An introduction of myself to the Exit Committee
2. What are the Behaviors that brought me to Harper?
3. What have I learned while attending Harper?
4. My goal after returning to my Home-School
5. Why I feel that I am ready to exit Harper.
