Planning/Budget

- Our ESSER funds will expire at the end of this year.
- I have one employee who is funded out of ESSER. She will be notified/reminded.
- Our enrollment projection is 614 for SY 24-25. At snapshot we had an enrollment of 638. Not sure if any staff will have to be cut. We are going to recruit through brochures, flyers, choice fairs, and attending parent meetings at our early childhood centers. We are concerned about enrollment due to the elementary opening of YES Prep nearby. It is our hope to keep our number above 600.

Curriculum:

- Texas Education Agency (TEA) has not officially released our school rating, but the district released a rating using the same formula. Our campus is rated an "A"! We are pleased that we were able to maintain this school rating. The school will continue to improve and give our students the best. We thank the students, parents, and staff. It takes a "village".
- The district is giving us an approved "menu" to choose from for curriculum that will be funded at the district level. The principal met with each grade level to discuss the choices and best fit for our campus. Our campus has selected the following:
 - Reading- HMH Reading
 - Math- StemScopes
 - Science- PHd Science
- Math, Science, Health Night- This event will be held on March 28 at 5:30 pm. We will have representatives from the Children's Museum, ABC dental and the public library. Teachers will have booths and make/take activities for students and parents. A light dinner will be served.
- GT Expo- This is an opportunity for our Gifted and Talented students to showcase their talents. Students researched topics and created projects to discuss their findings. This was a great event. We had good attendance by parents and other special guests. Two projects were selected to move on the district GT Expo.

- Career Day- This event will be held tomorrow. We are looking forward to seeing the different career opportunities our students can see. Our guest speakers are for 2-5 only. Students in lower grades can dress up as their desired careers.

Other:

- We have a short week next week. We have Chavez-Huerta Day and a Spring Holiday. We will not have school on Monday and Friday. The teachers know the expectation of working hard and staying focus Tuesday-Thursday.
