

## SDMC Meeting September 2019

Today's SDMC meeting started at 4:00 p.m.

The task the committee was asked to meet to discuss was communicated. The goal was to discuss the school improvement plan for the current school year and to consider modifications prior to final approval.

During discussion of the ELA part of the SIP (School Improvement Plan), Ms. Hayes advocated for additional emphasis on reading stamina and several options were presented as resources for teachers to use in the classroom. One resource that was discussed was MyOn, an online reading platform. It was determined that the campus would acquire a license for students to access e books with an interactive component.

A second area of discussion was the percentage of parents who expressed satisfaction with their son's/daughter's education. Several updates were needed on the SIP document to reflect the most current parent feedback.

The final area of discussion was on the college preparation courses. Ideas were shared about adding supports for students who are struggling with literacy to raise the success in the college preparation courses. The current school initiative to integrate language development across curriculum was discussed to support literacy development and to encourage students to attend the tutorial Sessions that are offered on Saturdays.

At the end of the meeting, members agreed to make the recommended updates to the SIP document and present it to the faculty for final approval.
