**Student Conduct:** Students should not engage in disruptive activities while in the classroom. Any conduct that is deemed detrimental to the academic atmosphere, such as cell phone use or consistently talking during instructional delivery, will not be tolerated. Any student found guilty of such conduct will be given the following consequences:

### Consequences:

1 <sup>st</sup> offense: Warning	3 <sup>rd</sup> offense: Detention
2 <sup>nd</sup> offense: Parent Notification	4 <sup>th</sup> offense: Referral

**Tardiness:** The student is responsible for getting to class on time. Chronic tardiness will lead to parent notification and appropriate disciplinary action. The student needs to be in class before the tardy bell. If the student is late he/she will need a **tardy pass** from the office to enter the classroom.

**Electronic Devices:** Any iPods, cell phones, or electronic device being used during class without teacher permission will be taken up and turned in to the office as described in the student handbook.

**Food or Drinks:** Only water in containers with a lid will be permitted. No other food or drinks are allowed during class.

**Make-Up work:** If absent, the student is responsible for asking the instructor for any work that was missed. Students will have one calendar week to complete and turn in any missing/ make-up work.

**Grading procedure:** Students will accumulate points throughout the nine weeks. Points will come from the following categories, and will be based on the following percentages:

- Homework/ Do Now/ Participation: 10%
- Formative Assessments: 50%
  - Exit Tickets
  - Quizzes
- Summative Assessments: 40%
  - Exams
  - Unit Projects

***In order to get credit for an assignment, the student must show his/her calculations. Late assignments must be turned in at most one calendar week after the due date for a maximum grade of 89. Assignments will not be accepted after one calendar week.***
