

## **Sharpstown High School SDMC Agenda**

**January 27, 2021**

The meeting began with a welcome to the new semester and overview of the calendar changes due to the late start. The principal reviewed the COVID dashboard and updated the committee on the total infections among students and staff. To date there have been 7 confirmed cases of COVID among students and 6 among school staff.

The committee was also briefed on the number of students attending face to face classes. There was discussion around the district plans for the Spring Semester and the principal indicated that no changes were being considered and students would still have the option to change their setting each six weeks.

The committee reviewed the budget and was informed that the district had restored funding that had been withheld at the beginning of the year. All regular programs are continuing the same as last year and we are adding a CTE Agriculture program. We currently have 80 students in the program which is an exceptional number for a first-year program. We expect the program to grow to the point that we will need an additional teacher by the 22-23 school year. The committee was also made aware of additional funding for teacher training and student tutorials and credit recovery.

The meeting ended with good news that we had 3 students advance in the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo Art contest.
