

Sharpstown High School SDMC Agenda

January 11, 2022

The meeting began at 4:30 via Zoom.

Mr. De Leon opened the meeting with a greeting and began discussing the enrollment for the second semester which was holding steady at 1724 which is a slight drop from October which was 1739. He explained that our high mobility rate means that students enroll and withdraw every day and this slight enrollment fluctuation is not uncommon.

He then discussed the results of the December End of Course STAAR results.

28% passed BIO, 34% passed ALG 1, 33% passed USH. These are improvement over previous years, but this year is difficult to compare to any other year due to the pandemic and the number of students that did not test last year.

We next discussed the final approval for the buildout of the 5 extended learning centers that will be completed over the summer. Although these five areas are being used as rooms now, they will have permanent walls and doors and will have improved lighting.

The meeting ended with a review of the Ready, Set Go plan for COVID and the continued restrictions and procedures that are in place with the district. We currently have 12 staff and 28 student cases.
