Uniform Policy 2018-2019

After reviewing the responses to the Dress Code survey sent home to all Askew families, the SDMC voted and unanimously decided to keep the Askew student Uniform with more stringent guidelines for students and teachers next year. The SDMC feels there is a need to reduce the number of choices for students and to ensure staff dress aligns with student dress. Students will wear red polos and navy bottoms. Jeans will be allowed on Fridays with an Askew spirit or college t-shirt. Consequences for students out of uniform were discussed including written notices to parents. An entry plan for 2018-2019 will be developed to address students being out of uniform first thing in the morning as they enter the building.

Lunch Visitor Policy 2018-2019

Because students have so little social time, Askew will implement a lunch visitor policy for next school year. The idea of limiting visits to certain days versus limiting the number of visits was discussed. A Monday, Wednesday, Friday only lunch policy was discussed.

Feedback/Concerns

- 1st grade asked if a procedure for an attendance check at the office for students that are tardy especially beyond the attendance bell.
- 3rd grade asked for additional support in the cafeteria during lunch (11:20-12:00).
- 4th grade asked for help with coverage when there isn't a substitute teacher. The idea of splitting the class into smaller groups amongst grade levels one above or below was suggested. Staff also asked about the shortage of custodial staff. Administration will reach out to Facility Services to clarify staffing. Also, grade level assemblies will be held to discuss restroom behavior with students.
