- o **PUA** **\$3,638.00 * 23 = -83,674**
- o Based on enrollment, we would need to give back \$83,674 due to the projections not meeting actual enrollment. ESSER will fund the after school program. We are currently working on promoting our Fine Arts programs, sports and after school which enrich a students experience that the charter schools may not offer. This is in addition to the B+ rating the school earned this past year.

- **Staff Dress Code Vote** - Dress code passed

The Edison faculty and staff will maintain a relaxed business casual dress code (PR-4) Pending SDMC Approval

1. Slacks, chinos, **jeans pants (no ragged)**, dress pants, and dressy cropped pants are acceptable.
2. Inappropriate pants include sweatpants, exercise pants, shorts, leggings, and any spandex or other form-fitting pants such as people wear for biking/exercising. Jeans are allowed with a collared shirt /polo or blouse, on Fridays only. No worn-out, faded, patched, written- on or torn jeans will be allowed.
3. Casual dresses and skirts to the knee are acceptable. Dress and skirt length should be at a length at which you can sit comfortably in public. Short, tight skirts that ride up the thigh are inappropriate for work.
4. Casual shirts, dress shirts, sweaters, tops, golf-type shirts, and turtlenecks are acceptable attire for work. Inappropriate attire for work includes tank tops; midriff tops; low-cut tops in the front/back; shirts with potentially offensive words, terms, logos, pictures, cartoons, or slogans.
5. **School Spirit T-Shirts are allowable on a daily basis.**
6. Shoes must be worn at all times. Flip-flops and slippers are not acceptable. Keep in mind that open toe shoes are a safety hazard, use your best judgment.
7. Hats are not appropriate indoors unless on “special theme” days. Head covers that are required for religious purposes or to honor cultural tradition are allowed.
