

## SDMC Meeting Minutes February 17, 2022

Attendees: Mr. Trevino, M. Mosley, L. Lin, A. Herrera, L. Moorefield, and C. Grossman.

Parents: Marisa Rodriguez, Yvonne Carter.

Meeting called to order at 3:26 p.m. Minutes from the last meeting approved. Grossman approved Mosley seconded.

Mr. Trevino shared that the next SDMC meeting will be on May 19, 2022.

Mr. Trevino explained what a Community of Practice entails, Red will get district visitors on February 23.

Ms. Marisa stated she received the district calendar. Mr. Trevino explained which calendar was voted on.

Mr. Trevino shared changes the district is planning to do for the next school year, such as the use of Canvas instead of the HUB.

It was shared that Red still has some vacancies in the Sped department, the financial clerk, as well as the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade bilingual position. Mr. Trevino asked if attendees knew of anyone who would be interested, Ms. Ivonne Carter said she would.

Mr. Trevino shared some changes Red will go through during the STAAR released and STAAR administration. There will be a STAAR released PLC on the Tuesday before spring break to give reading and math teachers 2 hours to plan and analyze STAAR release data to provide interventions to students in need. A pacing calendar will be developed by teachers. Ms. Moorefield and Mosley shared they are interested in participating in the PLC meeting to assist teachers in the planning. Ms. Marisa Rodriguez and Ms. Yvonne Carter shared they would be willing to help on the day of the PLC.

Mrs. Mosley explained what the STEM showcase entails and what her expectations are from students' projects. Upper grades will complete individual projects, primary grades may do a class project. The video can be as long as 10 minutes. Projects are due by March 25.

Mr. Trevino shared the STAAR administration dates. Mrs. Herrera asked what would happen with the students who are taking the test online while other students are taking it on paper. Mr. Trevino shared the students who will take it online will go to other classrooms and students who need to take it online, will go to the Computer Lab or the library.

Mr. Trevino shared Red's upcoming events.

Coach Grossman shared there will be Saturday tutorials on March 26 and asked if the kindergarten round-up and tutorials could be held on the same day, he said yes.

Ms. Yvonne and Ms. Rodriguez asked if this is the meeting where questions about reading interventions for struggling students. Ms. Carter shared his son is not getting services because he didn't qualify. They asked if we have enough interventionists at school? Are the kids getting enough assistance, as well as the teachers? Mr. Trevino said Ms. Sandling is our dyslexia interventionist, and that the school has other interventionists, Ms. Wade who works with 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students, Ms. Menefee (4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>) and Ms. Alvarez (3<sup>rd</sup>). Mr. Trevino shared parents need to reach out to the teachers first and ask them if their child have received interventions.
