

# April 22, 2019 SDMC Agenda Minutes

- 3:15—SDMC Survey
- Meeting called to order at 3:43
- Safety and security
  - Fire drill this week (?)
  - Intruder and inclement weather drill soon: read red book for procedures
  - Inclement weather: upstairs classes come downstairs
    - 3<sup>rd</sup> to Pk/K
    - 4<sup>th</sup> to 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>
    - 5<sup>th</sup> to Specials/2<sup>nd</sup> (if needed)
- Budget meetings
  - State may be assisting with funding (according to the News Sources but nothing has been put into effect/law yet)
  - Attendance 96.7
    - All grade levels are significantly lower than usual
    - Keep calling parents to get students to school on time
  - Enrollment: 942 (1 non-ADA)-----has gone up!
  - 934 is the projected enrollment for 2019-2020
  - Boys and Girls Club may be coming to Patterson next year. Will be a more cost-effective solution than YMCA.
- Curriculum and staff development
  - Consultant PYP visit April 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> ---Jan Esparza from Mexico City
    - He would like to have a meeting with the entire faculty; more information to come about that.
    - He will meet with the leadership team, will interview students, visit classrooms, meet with grade level teams OR a group of staff members, meet with parents
      - Questions he may ask:
        - What is working well?
        - What are the challenges?
        - Etc.
    - He will then send a report about what we need to improv on
    - We must **all** understand all UOI, what unit we are teaching, how we use inquiry, how we implement units, the use of planners, etc.

- Single subject or DL classrooms will need to justify and explain how we are being transdisciplinary without being self-contained
  - DL evaluation is still pending
    - Still waiting but should be fine
    - Spanish DL/Bilingual teachers must turn in their 40 hours of training for their stipend
  - IB Pre-Service Training
    - On-campus during our first week back to school training: will take 3 days
      - Will be delivered by IB consultants from California
    - IB Training at Chavez for some staff BEFORE school starts
      - August 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>
      - Mainly for new teachers who have not had any training
      - Teachers will be notified ASAP
- Questions, comments, and/or concerns
  - Deschenes reported that a parent is concerned that students are using cellphones during school hours (lunch, specials, restroom, hallways, etc) and posting on TikTok app
    - Be on the look out and confiscate phones, if need be.
      - Possible charge to get their cell phones back from admin
  - IB Mentee would like to bring her action piece to SDMC on May 6<sup>th</sup>
  - HPD will be doing a child safety and finger printing with 2<sup>nd</sup> grade
