Meeting called to order at 3:27

1. Visitor – 5th grade student Delilah R. Student spoke concerning her IB action piece, which relates to gender specific restroom. Her concern is that since there are many more female teachers, the adult restrooms should be gender neutral. She is suggesting that adult restrooms be relabeled in a gender-neutral manner. Motion was made and seconded to change staff restroom labels. Motion carried.
2. Safety and security
 - a. Shelter in place, inclement weather drill, fire drill, and intruder drill all need to be completed before the end of the year.
 - b. Budget
 - i. The district is allowing two waiver days during the ITC fire. Current attendance is 96.7, current enrollment is 940, projected enrollment is 934 for next year.
 - ii. 5th grade position that had been planned to close has been restored, a third-grade position will be closed, and a kindergarten position will be opened next year.
3. Curriculum and Staff Development
 - a. Dual Language evaluation still has not been received
 - b. Professional development plan for next year – first day August 12 and 3 days will be used for IB
 - c. IB report card – Mr. Saenz has developed an IB report card which will be issued this spring before the end of school.
 - d. IB feedback – a review of feedback from the consultant visit –
Positive – mission, student learning, respect, parent involvement, learner profile, agency and action, planning, reflection, implementation, PD time, system for planning, curriculum, etc
Improvement – student-initiated action, deeper understanding of action, daily schedules need more time for integrated inquiry, understanding of concept-based teaching and learning is lacking, stand alone content being taught, 50-80% of the instructional day should be devoted to the unit of inquiry, etc.
 - e. FACE -Family and Community Engagement – we have been awarded Gold status.
 - f. Festivals dates change for next year – Hispanic Heritage move to late September, International Festival end of October, Black History Program in February, and Exhibition in May.
