What is a School- Parent Compact?

A School-Parent Compact is a shared agreement and responsibility between the school, parent, and student to actively work unified toward student achievement. It explains how parents and teachers will effectively use all resources available, keep open communication throughout the school year, and identifies what every stakeholder involved will do to help the student be successful. academically, emotionally, and socially.

SCHOOL STAFF RESPONSIBILITIES

- ❖ Provide high quality instruction through the district's curriculum.
- ❖ Maintain positive communications between the school and home.
- ❖ Provide frequent reports to parents regarding the behavior and academic progress of the student.
- ❖ Schedule at least one Parent-Teacher Conference on an early dismissal day.
- ❖ Provide reasonable homework assignments with clear instructions.
- ❖ Ensure that all parents are invited to assist in the development/revision of the School-Parent Compact and the Parent and Family Engagement Policy.
- ❖ Provide information in the language spoken by the parent.
- ❖ Provide opportunities for parents to serve as volunteers and participate in family educational activities.
- ❖ Provide a safe school and follow safety procedures.
- ❖ Provide students interventions and after school tutorials.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- ❖ Communicate frequently with the teacher and attend at least two parent-teacher conferences.
- ❖ Make sure my child arrives on time and attends school every day with the necessary supplies.
- ❖ Support the school in its efforts to maintain proper discipline.
- ❖ Establish a time, place, and materials for homework.
- ❖ Promote positive activities after school and monitor time spent watching television and playing electronic games.
- ❖ Encourage my child to read 30 minutes daily and provide them books.
- ❖ Participate in my child's education by attending parent meetings and volunteering if possible.
- ❖ Establish routines at home, including homework time and appropriate bed times.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- ❖ Come to school on time with the necessary supplies and materials.
- ❖ Complete class work and homework assignments.
- ❖ Be responsible for my own personal property including textbooks and respect the property of others.
- ❖ Follow all the school rules.
- ❖ Ask for help when needed during the instructional day and/or homework.
- ❖ Be respectful towards adults and classmates always.
- ❖ Don't participate in bullying and if it occurs, report it to an adult.
- ❖ Be a leader and make the right choices.
- ❖ Read 30 minutes daily.
