New Teacher Appraisal System:

Adopting **T-TESS** will:

- Create an opportunity to collaboratively build a new appraisal system that **incorporates the wisdom and expertise** of HISD teachers and staff
- Allow teachers to receive **more specific feedback** on instructional practices using the five performance levels of in the T-TESS rubric
- Unlock a **vast array of state-provided resources** to support professional development, certification training, and appraiser calibration
- The T-TESS rubric will be **used for all observations and walkthroughs**. It comprises 4 domains, each containing 3-5 dimensions.
- On every dimension, teachers are rated between “Improvement Needed” and “Distinguished.” On formal observations and walkthroughs, teachers will receive a numerical score between 1-5 for each dimension.

Training for teachers was conducted on Thursday, May 26^h during the faculty meeting led by Principal Orozco.

Career Readiness:

In the advisor campus summer with Advisor E. Elizondo the students advising consist of proposed planning in hosting a summer program or back to school program for parents of incoming freshman at JFA for Fall 2022. Plan on supporting with the White Coat Ceremony on Thursday, June 2, 2022. Advisor has also requested to be included in campus teacher orientation when academic year commences. He is consistently assisting campus leadership and counselors.

Q/A:

Is there HCC courses this summer? Answer: Yes, JFA student will be able to take an opportunity to take summer courses with HCC. A total of 29 tenth graders, 49 ninth graders, 19 eleventh graders are projected to begin summer 1 courses on Monday, July 6. Summer 2 sessions begin on July 11th.
