- Bilingual Committee
 - ESL Block, ELLA-V being part of the ESL block, and TELPAS
- IB Committee
 - We are having visitors on Nov. 15. Teachers discuss best practices on delivering inquiry lessons. Matters to be address and recommendations were also discussed.

- Action follow-ups from last meeting minutes were reviewed and approved: Early dismissal flyers and call message, District uncapped (1st, 2nd, and 4th), Raz Plus approved, Imagine Learning was purchased.
- SIP Goals: One of the focus is attendance for this year which plays a huge role on the new accountability system. From 2017-2018 of 97% to 2018-2019 98% goal. We have design a great system that include motivational strategies, home visits, bulletin boards, etc.
- Wraparound Services Specialist, Mr. Delgado, supports a school community contacting parents, bring to our school some mentor, or wellness services. Teachers are encouraging to bring and concerns, ideas, students' needs to Mr. Delgado.
- New Programs to SRE: "Fun Clubs" In where students could rotate through it. Cheerleaders, soccer team, Zumba club/dance class, book character day, highlight an author day, board game club, electives during core enrichment, etc.
 - Highlight an author and Book Character Day: The teachers are encouraging to contact our librarian for support and suggestions. Second grade team would like to start these initiatives.
 - Tutorials and Saturday School will be open in where we want to emphasize English learning focusing on reading, writing, listening and speaking. In addition, we want to focus our teaching and learning on approaches, meets, and masters levels.
- New Business/Open Proposals
 - Budget cuts are coming. We are not getting as much budget as we anticipated for the enrollment count.
