Modified TADS: After gathering input from teachers and administrators across the district during five Teacher Appraisal Information & Feedback sessions in the spring of 2018, the Teacher Appraisal Working Committee accepted the recommendation to continue with our current Teacher Appraisal and Development System (TADS) rather than recommending transition to the Texas Teacher Evaluation and Support System (T-TESS). The committee also agreed to begin the process of making requested modifications to the existing system.

For the 2019-2020 school year, Leadership & Teacher Development has prioritized developing a modified version of TADS (M-TADS) which will resemble the previously adopted modified PDAS (M-PDAS).

Input on the potential M-TADS system was gathered during the Principals' Advisory Committee meeting on November 7, 2018. The survey, linked below, is based on the feedback received from meeting participants and was developed to obtain additional input from all TADS appraisers. Your response is needed by January 18.
