- **SCHOOL WIDE DISCUSSIONS**

- Mr. Johnson discussed the budget for the 2019-2020 school year. Currently, all funding has been allocated to meet the financial needs of the school for next year. Next year the campus will have to fund AVID and Mr. Johnson has agreed to pay the cost of the program because it is beneficial to the students. 1260 students are projected, and we need to meet that goal so that no money will be taken back. He went to a budget analyst to make sure we are on point with our money and will not have any deficits next year.
- The question was asked if we could have programs to encourage our students. Mr. Johnson explained that he went to strategic partnerships to secure money for possible extracurricular programs like Roses which motivates girls to improve their self-esteem and empowerment.
- Changes in campus personnel will be addressed as needed. The Spanish position has been advertised and two interviews have been set. Administrators will attend the teacher hiring fair to fill any vacant positions. The question was asked will positions be closed if we don't meet the projected student number and Mr. Johnson stated adjustments will be made if the need arises but no positions will be cut. Next year Hartman will be a dual language campus meaning that a cohort of students will be taught in Spanish for half of the day. History is slated to be the first dual language course and he is currently seeking a bilingual History teacher. Many of the students will come from Law elementary and Mr. Johnson has met with the parents to ensure them the program will remain of high quality in middle school.

- Ms. Fisher explained the various district/state tests that are occurring in May and she discussed the requirements for students attending summer school and the logistics for the campus.
- Mr. Johnson stated that elections for the new SDMC will take place in May and staff members may nominate themselves or someone else to be on the SDMC.

The school uniforms for next school year were brought up as a concern. Mr. Johnson stated that no jeans of any kind will be allowed, and the students will continue to wear the polos with the school logo.
