Additional Required School Responsibilities

Shadydale Elementary School will:

- Hold an annual meeting to inform parents of the school's participation in Title I, Part A programs, and to explain the Title I, Part A program requirements, and the right of parents to be involved.

- Convene an annual Title I meeting at a convenient time to parents, so as many parents as possible can attend.
