Minutes:

On Friday, October 29, 2021, the SDMC Committee met to discuss the following topics:

PEIMS Snapshot: As a campus, we did not meet our projection of 494 scholars. During the year, we were at 484, however as the months progressed, many families relocated to other districts. We also lost twenty scholars due to capping in Bilingual Kindergarten, ESL Kindergarten, and first Grade Regular. As a HUB school, we did not see an influx of scholars.

Budget: Because we did not meet our projection by the 2021-2022 PEMIS Snapshot, we will have a scheduled meeting with our budget analysis to adjust the budget. As a proactive measure, We closed three teaching positions earlier in the year to cover the cost. Therefore, there will not be a need to release anyone at this time.

ESSER Funds: We are excited about the ESSER Funds for Benbrook, especially the funds to address the learning loss for our scholars. Highly Effective Teachers will have an opportunity to provide tutorials at the rate of 50 dollars an hour. It was recommended that the SDMC Committee develop a job description for interested parties. The focus will be on student success rate and academic growth. Teachers will be required to provide the following:

Explicit Instruction
Exit tickets at the end of each session
Progress monitoring
List of individual student TEKS
Student conference information

Social Economically Disadvantaged: We are glad to report that we had 100% of your scholars submit their Eco Dis Forms. We also were able to capture 95% of our scholars who met the qualifications. We increased from last year's percentage of 93.9 by 1.1%. Shout out to everyone for their dedication and hard work that has led to our success.

Yancy Life: One of the Business Partners this year is Yancy Life. The company provides classroom tutors to meet the needs of our 4th-grade scholars. We were recently informed that the company would provide two additional support at no charge. We will work with the tutors to provide training and guidelines to ensure student academic growth.

DDIS: This year, we have been assigned a DDIS to support our goal to be an "A" rated campus. We will meet officially with our DDIS on November 4. They have developed a Pathways Plan exclusively for Benbrook. This will be a virtual meeting. The sole purpose of the DDIS is to provide support with creating reports that will capture where we are as a campus so that we may drill down to the root cause.
