*Budgetary Updates – Budget meeting scheduled this Thursday. Resource allocation form/allocations reviewed. We had a “frugal Fall” in anticipation of possible budget cuts due to last year’s low attendance percentages.

*New Teacher in PALS – Mr. Joseph Evans has joined Briscoe’s staff as the new PALS teacher.

*Data District Level Assessments/SNAPSHOTS schedule...GLOWS and GROWS – CIRCLE MOY testing continues for PreK. HFWE (2nd administration) will take place in the Spring. Imagine Learning reports were compiled and profiles were provided/viewed. Members were made aware of ELA district online testing error – entire test was read to all online students instead of only the answers being read to them. Concerns for online testing include students playing with screens and issues with “freezing” due to inactivity. HISD technology dept had sent someone out to check computers and our broadband was fine for online DLA test administration. DLA testing went well. Feedback from teachers will be used to “tweak” session set-up for next round of DLAs.

*Student Assistance Forms...Wrap-Around Specialist and the Holidays – Continue to send WRS a student referral form when requesting assistance for the child. RE Backpack Buddies – food will go home on Fridays when we return from Winter Break.

*ADA Themed holiday Tracker Update – Students have been participating in daily activities. Prize drawing for gift cards will be held as scheduled on December 19th with students qualifying for drawing based on attendance. (1 ticket for 85% attendance; 2 tickets for 100% attendance)
