Ms. Cantu welcomes everybody after personal introductions. Ms. Cantu explains the purpose of the SIP and that this year we are still a B but no distinctions. Ms. Cantu communicates that our SIP has changed in template and that it is a living document and that notes from last year's recommendations as well as recommendations from community we needed to tweak the SIP for deeper content and knowledge. The budget considerations were also talked about as they discussed the SIP. Mrs. Cantu brings up the meeting with office of school choice and that from what the SMC has been talking about since 2017 about the school becoming a K-8 is now slowly coming to fruition. She also mentioned that Rebuilding Together Houston has been supporting the school in making Latham our drop off location by creating bridges above coverts that the City of Houston will put in place. She also mentioned that they will help revitalize our habitat as well. She praises the efforts of Ms. Hulsey and community for making this possible. Ms. Hulsey reiterates the need of highlighting the great performance of our school this past year.

Ms. Cantu the talks about the changes in the SIP from last year. She goes over the district strategic priorities on page one. Then she talks about the change in the mission statement from the previous years according to their guidance and conversations within the SDMC team last year as well as with correlating it to becoming a K-8 school.

Ms. Cantu now mentions that our enrollment as of today is slightly below the expected numbers. We are below by 24 students which is a negative of \$78,000. This impact is in all our budget areas. We were able to keep the staff and not risk waivers, but we will need to be mindful of where our spending goes.

The committee continues to look at each aspect of the SIP and the budgetary implications.

Ms. Hutchins motions for the 2019-2020 SIP approval. Mrs. Hulsey seconds the motion and Ms. Espinoza also second the motion to approve the SIP.
