<p><b>Budget</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Budget is reduced</li><li>• No Teacher will be Cut</li><li>• Remaining Funds will be used for Teacher Laptops and Printers as a priority</li></ul> <p><b>Tutorials Beginning in January 26, 2020</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Kinder through 5th</li><li>• Two Days a Week, 3:15 – 4:15</li><li>• We will provide all RV classes</li><li>• We will provide all IP classes</li><li>• Concurrent classes will NOT be held</li></ul> <p><b>Instructional Models</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Concurrent Model – Least Effective</b></li><li>• <b>Split Staffing Model</b> – Happening in our Departmentalized Classes, <b>Somewhat Effective</b>. Concern: Not all teachers are instructionally engaged in lessons in the manner we are doing it now. <b>Can be more effective if some teachers only due IP for their grade and others do RV for their grade.</b></li><li>• <b>Split Scheduling</b> – Most Effective. Requires that IP and RV students be taught during different parts of the day.</li></ul> <p><b>TADS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• MTADS Teachers may receive an additional walk-through or observation depending on what was observed on the required ones.</li><li>• Portfolios are due February 1.
