T. H. Rogers After-School Enrichment Program Policies and Procedures

Thank you for your interest in our Enrichment program at T H Rogers. Please find important information to assist with your decision on which classes you would like for your child(ren) to participate in this semester. The deadline for registration is January 10, 2020. REGISTRATION FEE \$25.00. Registration is complete only upon receipt of a signed registration form and at least 1/2 of the payment due. You may submit your payment either by Check, Money Order or School Pay.

EXTENDED PAYMENT PLAN is available to you as a convenience. We are solely dependent on payment of tuition and fees to meet our expenses. First payment (1/2 of Grand Total) is due upon registration; Second payment (1/2 of Grand Total) is due Monday, March 2, 2020.

CLASS CANCELLATION. If your child is enrolled in an Enrichment class and it is canceled due to lack of enrollment, a full refund for that class will be issued.

CONDUCT/DISCIPLINE. Children enrolled in Enrichment classes are expected to follow the HISD Code of Conduct required at T. H. Rogers. Children who fail to conduct themselves according to this standard will be given a warning and their parents will be notified of their misconduct. Continued misconduct will result in notification to T. H. Rogers' administrators and/or suspension from the Enrichment Program. Children suspended from the Enrichment program for misconduct will not be entitled to a refund of any tuition, fees, or registration paid.

COURSES. Monday and Friday classes are 12 sessions. Thursday classes are 14 sessions. There will be no classes on early dismissal days.

Art K – 5

Friday

Tuition - \$175

Students will learn the Elements of Shape and how to use them in creating drawings. Each class encourages students to perfect their technique through a variety of media while also improving their drawing skills. Instructed by: Monart School of Art

Basketball (K-6)

Thursday

Tuition - \$190

This program is open to players of all abilities. Our aim is for players to attend an organized coached session after school in order to be taught the key skills of the game. Instructed by: Coach Craft/Stafford (T H Rogers)

Cake Decorating (K-8)

Tuition - \$210

Ceramics (2-8)

Thursday

Tuition - \$205

Students will be working with high fire clay. They will start by covering fundamental skills in hand-building and progressively advancing to more complex forms. Each piece has to completely dry over 2 – 3 weeks before it is bisque fired, glazed and then fired again to stoneware. Instructed by: Monart School of Art

Cooking (K-6)

Thursday

Tuition - \$220

Chef Ellen is dedicated to giving every child the experience of a positive connection to food and empowering them to cook for themselves and their families. Chef Ellen is a private chef and culinary instructor whose love of teaching has targeted a variety of audiences in Houston for over 15 years. Instructed by: Chef Ellen

Gymnastics (K-5)**Friday****Tuition - \$175**

We will work in the areas of floor tumbling, balance beam and mini trampoline. In all our classes we mix in health, fitness and well being along with some humor. Our goal is not to build Olympians but to help shape healthy, happy, confident kids.

Karate/Martial Arts (K-8)**Thursday****Tuition - \$195**

Mad Science (K-6)**Thursday****Tuition - \$205**

They will understand how things work through hands-on activities that demonstrate the principles of simple and motorized machines, while learning skills of team-work, problem-solving and creative thinking. Soccer (K-5)**Monday****Tuition - \$190**

This class is geared for all levels of soccer experience. As the class progresses your child will be introduced to passing the ball, receiving the ball when passed to them, enhancing their shooting skills, improving their foot-eye coordination and learn how to turnaround with the ball. Writing (2-8)**Monday****Tuition - \$200**

Storybook illustration: This is a creative writing course in which students both write and illustrate their own story. This class allows students to advance both writing and drawing skills, and is one of our most popular after-school programs. Instructed by: Monart School of Art
