HISD adds six schools to curbside summer meals program

New sites replace three schools no longer serving as distribution sites

June 3, 2020 – The Houston Independent School District has added six school sites to its curbside Summer Meals program, which launched Monday, June 1.

New locations include:

- Holland Middle School, 1600 Gellhorn Dr.; 10 a.m. to noon
- Pilgrim Academy, 6302 Skyline Dr.; 10 a.m. to noon
- Shadowbriar Elementary School, 2650 Shadowbriar Dr.; noon to 2 p.m.
- Ashford Elementary School, 1815 Shannon Valley Dr.; 10 a.m. to noon
- Piney Point Elementary School, 8921 Pagewood Lane; noon to 2 p.m.
- Emerson Elementary School, 9533 Skyline Dr.; 10 a.m. to noon

These six locations replace three locations — Halpin Early Childhood Center and Pleasantville and Young elementary schools — that will no longer serve as distribution sites.
