



COVID-19 Frequently Asked Questions
Seniors 2020

1. Will Senior events like prom, senior trip, and graduation still happen?

ANSWER: Per Houston ISD all school events scheduled for May are cancelled. The Superintendent and school district will decide if schools will have a virtual graduation or a face-to-face graduation later in the summer. These decisions will be based on the guidelines and mandates set forth by the state, county and TEA. We will keep you updated as decisions are made.

2. Can I get a reimbursement for my Senior dues?

ANSWER: HAIS is working with Houston ISD to issue reimbursements to seniors and parents that paid Senior dues. We will email parents and students when the payments are ready.

3. I have questions about college. Will my transcript be sent to my university at the end of the year?

ANSWER: Ms. Courville and Ms. Simpson are still working with seniors to complete college applications, scholarships, and sorting out new virtual college visits. All Seniors are enrolled in AVID and should be meeting with Ms. Courville-Williams weekly. As Registrar, Ms. Courville will finalize all transcripts and graduate students following Houston ISD guidelines. Final transcripts will be sent via Naviance or US Mail to colleges and universities once all grades and credits are complete. 4. How will I complete Senior Sign-Out?

ANSWER: HAIS administrators are working together with HISD to ensure the end of the year is a smooth process in our new virtual world. We will communicate about laptop pick-up, textbook returns, credit checks, NG removal (attendance), and all other end of year paper work before the end of May.
