Introduction of members and the purpose of the committee/goals of the 2019/2020 school year

**SIP**

- SDMC conducted final review of the SIP. Each administrator spoke on the goals listed within their department. The administrator presented on last year's data and growth- along with the strategies designed to be implemented to assist in reaching each goal. The 2019/2020 goals were created bases on the input of all stakeholders within each department.

**Student Achievement (English):** By the end of 2019-2020 school year, English I and English II will increase by 5% in meets and masters.

**Student Achievement (Math):** By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, Algebra I EOC scores with increase by 5% in meets and masters

**Student Achievement Domains (Closing the Gaps):** By the end of 2019-2020 school year, English I, English II, Algebra I, and Biology will increase the number of students who exceed their STAAR progress measures by 5%.

**Student Achievement (Post-Secondary Readiness):** Increase number of students who achieve the college ready benchmark of 480 for reading and 580 for math by 5%. Improve the MET TSI

criteria in both ELA/Reading and Math by 5%. We will increase students who achieve a 3 or higher by 5% on A.P. Exams

**Student Achievement (Attendance):** Improve attendance rating by 3%, moving from a 94% to a 97%.

#### **Early Dismissal:**

- Reviewed the student bell schedule for half days. Made minor adjustments to the lunch schedule
- Voted on and approved the bell schedule
- Reviewed teacher expectations for after student release

#### **Discipline:**

- Focus on decreasing level I and II Discipline infractions
- Will focus on no use of cell phones during instructional time to decrease behavior problems
- Host restorative circles with students for first infractions
- Train faculty and staff on identification of gang affiliations

#### **Faculty and Student Parking**

- Lopez will create designated places for staff and student parking
- Students will have to provide drivers license, and proof of insurance to purchase parking space
- Student cars will be tagged the first time they park in lot without permit, second time the cars will be towed

#### **After School Activities**

- All teachers are in charge of a club and sports and must remain with students
- Clubs are available in the afternoon
- All students not in a school sponsored activity must be off the campus no later than 4pm
