A. Campus Enrollment

1. Student Mobility Rate

*In comparison to 2017-2018, 2018-2019, and 2019-2020, the enrollment has declined. Some students have transferred to area charter schools. This is not unusual. Students normally leave after completing kindergarten. This is especially true for the Hispanic population.

*Ways to retain students:

- provide technology to students to compete with area charters.
- offer additional programming that attract students. (music)

B. Return to Face-to Face Instruction

*Students are returning face to face. Parents have had a chance to select learning modes for their scholars. All classrooms have been set up for social distancing and teachers have been rotating in and out to work in their rooms. Frost is holding a Re-Opening House today to provide parents with additional information and support.

1. Opening Procedures

Stakeholders have reviewed the opening day procedures and parents will receive additional information during the re-opening house.

2. District CDC Plan

All classrooms have been set up to meet the guidelines of the district CDC. We will continue to make adjustment to address the needs of the campus and to provide our students with quality instruction.

3. Learning Mode Selection

Parents will be allowed to change the learning selection every 6 weeks. We will address spacing and campus needs at least two to the three weeks prior to students returning.

C. Campus Budget

We are closely monitoring our budget. Our projection was higher than the number of students that we currently have enrolled. We will also continue to enroll students to bring our scholars back to their neighborhood school.
