

Health Course Credit at Kinder HSPVA (Updated April 2020)

Health is a required one semester course in the state of Texas that every high school student must complete as part of the prescribed degree plan. Due to the additional Art Area credit requirements at Kinder HSPVA, the school has been granted a waiver which allows Health to be embedded into the Biology course curriculum. If you have not taken Health and are an incoming 9th grade student, you will earn your Health credit while taking Biology.

If you have already taken Biology but have not yet earned the required Health credit, the student will be responsible for earning the 0.5 Health credit through a source outside Kinder HSPVA. The first source we recommend is Texas Tech University Online High School (TTUISHD- see link below). Other accredited online high school programs may also be acceptable, with pre-approval from a Counselor. In addition, Health credit ("original credit") may be available through your zoned school's summer school program; speak to their Counselor or Registrar. The deadline to complete this credit is by the end of Freshman year.
