Theatre Courses

There are a multitude of Theatre courses for students to choose from. However, each student entering the Theatre Program (per District and TEA Rules) must take and pass;

1. Theatre Arts I or Technical Theatre I.
2. Upon completion, students may continue to Theatre II or Tech II
OR Audition for Theatrical Production I
3. Upon completion, students may continue to Theatre III or Tech III
OR Audition for Theatrical Production I-III
4. Upon completion, students may continue to Theatre IV or Tech IV
OR Audition for Theatrical Production.

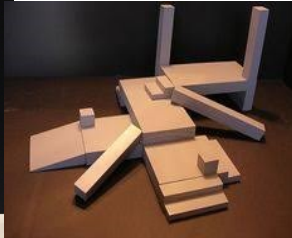
