# SDMC Committee Meeting

## MINUTES

Meeting was called to order at 3:15 p.m. Sign in sheet reflects those present, Principal Garrett welcomed everyone and thanked them for their participation, SDMC serves as an Advisory committee.

- New Business – STAAR Math Goals are 85% to get to an A rating and 75% minimum goal to stay at a B rating the difference of 10% is only 10 students. Campus supports include Literacy Now, Career Pathways, Imagine Learning Math and Reading, and Learning A-Z. Literacy Now cost is \$15,000.00 for 28 students, they received a grant to double our students for the same cost, they will be servicing 56 students this school year. We have seen growth in those students that receive this intervention. Career Pathways has provided training to Ms. Barber for Data Tracking and she is our Data Tracking and Assessment Specialist. Learning A-Z and Imagine Reading and Math are being provided by the district to all HISD campuses. Closing the gaps- there are specific targets we don't meet but we do meet Literacy. Focusing on literacy will impact student outcomes across all grade levels and content area. Attendance goals for this year is 97.5 or greater, 2019-2020 we were right below 97%. We will not offer attendance incentives this year. We have a new counselor Ms. Guzman and she will help implement supports for those students that are chronically absent or tardy. We will contact students who are not online. Safety Team – Nurse Kennedy, Mr. Benton PE teacher, and Admin. Ms. Hensley will ensure that all our students take digital safety class and she does it thru library classes and tracks that it is done but as of right now we will have to do it on HUB. Ms. Guzman will support our students virtually and she will help with referrals to Harris Center. A campus priority is to increase our parent involvement in the virtual setting, we will have parent meetings online. No campus meetings at this time due to COVID we will have to get creative.



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- New Business – Recipe for Success- will not offer cooking and gardening. They are considering afterschool classes. Sub-pops EL's, GT, SPED, Economically Disadvantaged and At Risk are our Domain 3, we will monitor students on Formative Assessments to ensure that are well prepared for STAAR. Imagine contest will begin earlier virtually to keep up the momentum that was built form last year. Tutorials will begin in after the BOY; the tutorials will be virtual and based on need. Dyslexia support services we have 2 specialists on campus. Title I overview: Literacy Now, TEACH, tutorials, instructional resources and personnel will be paid from Title I. Schoolwide formative assessments and common assessments will be used to track students and their areas of need. Kagan Strategies, Imagine Reading and Imagine Math will be used as we did last year to help increase student growth. Parent involvement online suggestions are needed. Health and Medical Services – Requirements are being met by Nurse Kennedy in absence of Nurse Kennedy Ms. Hernandez and Ms. Perez are back-up. Ms. Garrett presented SIP and if agreed upon she will present for a vote by teachers. SDMC Committee voted and approved SIP
- Concerns – Parent concern about student not being able to log on to TEAMS. Ms. Garrett stated that the District is providing updates and training. Can we add to class dojo story? Yes, we can.
