MINUTES

Meeting was called to order at 3:15 p.m. Sign in sheet reflects those present, Principal Garrett welcomed everyone and thanked them for their participation, SDMC serves as an Advisory committee.

- Standing Business
 - Attendance Review – Student attendance has increased since the parent calls have been made both in the morning and the afternoon. Student attendance 2020-2021 is 96.3% last year 97.2% we are striving for a minimum of 96.5%, campus attendance affects both our students academically and our campus financially.
 - Special Education Updates – Ms. Jones informed of ESY services; students who are designated as Resource will not qualify for these services. We will continue providing our Resource students regular summer school services. Special Education Transportation is also in the works and Special Education Students' 5th grade promotional ARDs are upcoming and Ms. Jones will schedule.
 - Safety and Security – As of right now we do not have any concerns. We always want to be mindful of supervising our students and ensuring that students always wear their mask.
- New Business
 - 3rd Grade Dictionary Donation – these were donated by Rotary Club; additional dictionaries were ordered for 4th and 5th for testing.
 - Assessment – DLA was last assessment since snapshot was canceled, we do have data for high frequency words, of our students in 1st grade 82% passed the test and in 2nd grade 88% passed the test in MOY. Mock STAAR will be done by grade level to avoid campus interruptions.
 - Intervention - Catapult Tutoring will be starting for our 3rd grade Reading/Math and 4th grade Math to prepare students for STAAR and also give them a better foundation for next school year. Tutorials are still on going for our students in grades 1st – 5th and Saturday tutorials pending staff availability.

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- New Business
 - Planning – Survey about 2021-2022 PD will be sent out to teachers to determine areas of need. HB3 will be expanding to 1st & 3rd ELA thus far Kindergarten teachers, Special Education teachers and Principals have completed this training.
 - Budget – We can expect to have less funding next year. Based on enrollment we have seen a lot of mobility. We have a lot of Pre-k applications and we are hoping that they all come to help stabilize our campus numbers. Ms. Garrett will be meeting with her budget analyst to help plan for the next school year. Though our budget might be tight the academic resources that are needed will be provided.
 - SDMC Parent Representative – has moved we are working on getting a new parent but the parents that we have asked to serve are not able to serve at this time.
 - Summer school qualification – How will students qualify for summer school? A spread sheet provided by the district and campus recommendations will determine which students will attend summer school.
