- Introductions of all Committee Members
 - All members but Ms. Catalon were present in today's meeting.
- New Personnel
 - All 21 teacher positions have been filed.
- COVID -19 Safety
 - PPE equipment must be worn while on campus and constantly communicate social distancing and keeping doors closed so that everyone on campus remains safe while on campus. If individuals have the slightest COVID - 19 symptom, everyone is required to stay home.
 - Committee members were allowed to ask questions and state concerns related to COVID
- Essential Agreement were shared
- Roles and Responsibilities
 - The meaning and purpose of SDMC was shared with the committee
 - All SDMC members serve a 2 year term until reelected
 - Assist the principal in PD sessions and other decision making opportunities that arise throughout the school year.
- Reopening Updates
 - Paper based curriculum is not a possibility due to lack of accountability as it relates to attendance and student work times.
 - Synchronous and Asynchronous instruction was defined
 - All Patterson teachers will teach synchronously for 30 minutes in each content area and students will engage in 60 minutes of asynchronous instruction in each content area as well daily.
 - Students are marked present if they are present by their teacher in a synchronous lesson. If they are not present in a synchronous class, students must reach out to the teacher and complete all of their daily assignments to be counted as present for that particular day per TEA guidelines.
 - Attendance and grades count and they matter during virtual learning.
 - Students are projected to return back on campus for FTF instruction on October 19,2020
 - 1:10 student and teacher ratio will be in a classroom
 - Students will engage in an A/B block teaching schedule
 - Students will be split each day in FTF instruction and Virtual instruction until we reopen at 100% capacity.
 - If anyone is infected on campus, we will have to shut the campus down so that the campus will be sanitized.
 - **Technology Updates**

- **Learning centers**

- Students who do not have devices will participate in virtual learning by way of learning centers.
- Currently we have about 180 students who are without technology.
- PTO will be contacted to request that they purchase additional technology that is needed.
- Input requested for Vontoure Math curriculum to be used for 2nd-5th grade students. Teacher training will be conducted one a month by the curriculum writer. Ms. Quinones shared personal testimony on the results of the Vontoure program.
- Patteson will no longer engage in the UDL program.
- Mr. Saenz and Ms. Deschenes shared the success of the Sharon Wells curriculum was discussed with the committee as it pertains to STAAR data
- Mr. Saenz walked the team through all curriculum development information for the Vontoure Math curriculum. Math teachers were able to ask questions.
- Ms. Deschens shared that she likes that the curriculum uses many of the virtual platforms teachers are encouraged to use.
- If we go with a cohort the course will lower because we will be able to split the cost financially with another campus.
- Parent representative suggested that we request the funds from our campus PTO because the program reaches many students on our campus.
- Sumit K through Science is a digital and paper based platform suggest by Mr. Saenz
- If purchased, all 3rd- 5th grade students will be given a license to the program to prepare for the Science STAAR test.
- Mr. Saenz has coordinated a demo on Thursday, September 3,2020 for all 5th grade teachers to attend
- Sumit K has a 100% passing rate guaranteed if all students successfully follow their scope and sequence prior to the STAAR testing. If the students do not pass their Science STAAR test.
- Committee spoke about integrating IB elements with Sumit K if we choose to go forward.
- Ms. Deschens proposed a vote for the Vontoure Math and Sumit K. The vote was unanimous.

- IB Elementary
- Patterson is the first authorized IB campus in the East region
- Due to virtual instruction, teachers are able to teach less units to ensure student interaction
- Accountability
 - We are currently a 'B' rated campus

- Mr. Saenz stated his desire to be a TEA rated 'A' campus by the 2021-2022 school year
