Materials/Supply Sharing Recommendations

VIRTUAL AND IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION

ART ROOM MATERIALS/SUPPLY SHARING

Students are to have a Student Single-Use (SSU) Kit including sketchbook. These kits will serve as the students' basic supplies in the classroom and for virtual learning at home. SSU supplies are materials needed to complete the basic work for the course. If space in the art classroom is an issue, students can keep their SSU in their backpack, locker, homeroom/advocacy classroom, etc. All SSU supplies must be kept in a zipper top plastic bag for easy carry and cleaning. These supplies are not to be shared. **Disinfecting of supplies/materials to use for specific projects for in-person instruction:** Supplies specific to the lesson must be provided for each student in each class. Supplies once disinfected can be reused, follow district guidelines for disinfecting supplies. Supplies are supplied by the home campus and/or student. Replenish as needed.

VIRTUAL/IN-PERSON SSU KIT ELEMENTARY

Crayons, Colored pencils, Markers, Glue, Glue stick, Eraser, Watercolor palette, Construction paper, Sketchbook, Oil pastel, Pencils, Pens, Scissors, Pencil sharpener, Protractor or ruler, Protective clothing covering, all stored in a 2-gallon sized zipper top plastic bag. Appropriately labeled with student's name, teacher name, and class period. Replenish as needed. Sketchbooks are for individual use only.

VIRTUAL/IN-PERSON SSU KIT SECONDARY

Colored pencils (24-36 minimum), 2-3 drawing pencils, Eraser, Stumps, Glue, Glue stick, Black marker, Oil pastel, Paper, Scissors, Sketchbook, Watercolor palette, Pencil sharpener, Black pen, 2 pencils, Protractor or ruler, Protective clothing covering, all stored in a 2-gallon sized zipper top plastic bag. Appropriately labeled with student's name, teacher name, and class period. Replenish as needed. Sketchbooks are for individual use only.

EQUIPMENT SHARING (IN-PERSON)

Distribution of disinfected equipment at the beginning of each class. Collection of disinfected equipment at the end of class must be collected with proper social

distancing. Example of equipment: mirrors, ceramic tools, printmaking tools, etc.

TECHNOLOGY USE FOR RESOURCE DEMONSTRATION (IN-PERSON)

District approved disinfectant provided and used on the following: historical works and/or example works are to be shared through the HUB and/or projected. Tangible examples must be laminated when possible and class-set created, for proper cleaning.

ART ROOM LIBRARY (IN-PERSON)

District approved disinfectant provided and used on the following: All books, manipulatives accompanying books, bookshelves, bins etc. Single use for all listed above until disinfected. Procedures established for all art room libraries for proper cleaning.

ART ROOM SINK AREA (IN-PERSON)

District guidelines followed for disinfecting surface areas. Social distancing guidelines followed for hand washing. Procedures established for all art room sink area specific to space.
