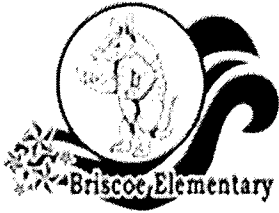

*Shout-Outs/Celebrations: All staff members continue to work together to keep everyone safe by wearing masks, continuing with social distancing, and encouraging the use of hand sanitizer/handwashing. These efforts have kept our campus COVID cases at a minimum.

*Staff Updates: 2 staff members are out on FMLA. Both are due back in January.

*Budgetary Impacts for 20201: Power Point presentation outlined the school budget being discussed. Briscoe will have to “pay back” funds to the district due to lower-than-projected enrollment. However, the district is asking schools to “pay back” only ½ of what is actually owed (as well as only giving schools ½ of what they were to receive if they met/exceeded enrollment projection). Briscoe will also receive additional funding from Small School Subsidy to supplement our regular school budget.

*Schedules for Spring 2021: At this time, all teaching schedules will remain the same as no staff changes are needed or anticipated for the remainder of the school year.

*Testing Calendar for Spring: There was mention of upcoming test assessments for January...

*Instructional Rounds, Spring 2021: Coaching will continue. Evidence of learning noted during walk-throughs and classroom visits. Effective PLC session involved teachers visiting other classrooms to observe best practices. Teachers are reminded that they can initiate the visits without waiting for a special PLC session to do so.

*Questions, Comments, and Concerns: Ms. Alvarado was conducting a home visit during the PLC meeting but she was able to join the meeting “on location”. She spoke about Angels in the Outfield – a group young men who are former Briscoe students that provide gifts for 20 children each year. This year, due to COVID and visitor restrictions, Angels in the Outfield will provide gift cards that Ms. Alvarado will distribute to selected students so they can purchase their own gift from Walmart! Also, Ms. Alvarado is continuing to contact students who have not yet collected their free books from the school so they can have books to read at home during Winter Break.
