Topic(s)	Key Points
Arrival and Dismissal  Daily Routines	<ul> <li>Doors will open at 7:45 am only for students who wish to have breakfast.</li> <li>There will be no supervision prior to 7:45 am.</li> <li>There will be no common waiting areas before or after school.</li> <li>Student who are not having breakfast must wait in cars until 7:55 am.</li> <li>Students who wish to have breakfast will pick up breakfast tray from serving line and go to their first class to eat their breakfast</li> <li>All students need to exit the building immediately after school ends at 3:35 pm (emphasize small school and small staft)</li> <li>Students will enter and exit the building using the Challenge Main Entrance Double Doors ONLY</li> <li>Drop off and pickup location for students will be through the Challenge Parking Lot Only (facing Home Depot)</li> <li>There will be no supervision before 7:45 am and after 3:45 pm.</li> <li>Students will not be allowed to wait at HCC for rides.</li> <li>There will be no changes to this year's schedule.</li> <li>Students will need to ask teachers for permission to use the restroom during class time (only one student at a time may leave the classroom).</li> <li>Students will not be allowed to use the restroom during passing.</li> <li>Hall and stairways will be one directional.</li> <li>Students will need to go straight to their next class during the passing periods.</li> <li>All classroom desks will be facing the same direction.</li> <li>Students will be seated in study halls every day during college class periods. HCC will not be open.</li> <li>Due to the size of the classrooms, some students may have to be seated in common areas due to the distance required</li> </ul>
Instruction	<ul> <li>Students coming to campus must bring their laptop EVERY DAY</li> <li>Instruction will be equitable to what students are receiving at home.</li> <li>Students at home and in person will continue the same teachers and participate in the same lessons and assignments.</li> <li>Students will need ear buds EVERY DAY for in person instruction</li> </ul>
Transportation	Route Information will be provided directly to families receiving transportation.

Student and Staff Safety	<ul> <li>Students and staff are required to properly wear masks in the building, at all times (nose and mouth covered).</li> <li>Staff and students must undergo health screening and students' temperatures will be taken upon entry.</li> <li>Visitors will not be allowed in school (i.e., family members of staff, former students, etc)</li> <li>Parent must make an appointment prior to coming to school and it must be for official school business only.</li> <li>If parents need to check out a student for any reason, the parent must call before coming to campus.</li> <li>Campus visitors will be limited and required to be screened before entering the building and required to wear PPE</li> <li>All students and staff are required to wear PPE</li> <li>PPE will be provided daily for students and staff (however students and staff can wear their own PPE if appropriate for work/orschool)</li> <li>The number of students in each class will be limited</li> <li>Based on the size of the classroom</li> <li>Physical spacing will be maintained between desk (equal physical distancing between all desk)</li> <li>Students will face the same direction</li> <li>(Class configuration changed based on modified CDC guidance)</li> <li>Students may not share belongings, equipment, (e.g., computer, instruments, water bottles, costumes, uniforms, etc)</li> <li>Students may not share instructional materials (laptops, reding materials, etc) unless it is covered by plastic wrap.</li> <li>Water Fountains will be off limits.</li> <li>Students must bring enough water to school to last all day.</li> <li>Signage throughout the building (Hand washing, appropriate mask wearing, and physical spacing)</li> <li>Classroom cleaning kit (1 per classroom)</li> <li>Gloves</li> <li>Sanitizer</li> <li>Disinfectant wipes</li> </ul>
