Please don't stop reading my e-mails. I apologize for the number coming your way lately.

I am writing to tell you that today we received reports of a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 on our campus. The last time the individual was on campus was Monday, February 1, 2021. Please be advised that our school will remain open.

HISD Health and Medical Services, in consultation with the Houston Health Department, evaluates all the evidence and the totality of the circumstances in alignment with CDC guidelines to determine whether the campus should be closed on a case by case basis.

As a precautionary measure, our campus will be deep cleaned and disinfected again tonight as outlined in the HISD Communicable Disease Plan.

Nurse Jordan will notify any student or staff member who is believed to have been exposed to COVID-19 after conducting contact tracing. We continue to remain focused on two key priorities – providing our students with a high-quality education and ensuring the safety of both our students and staff as we navigate this pandemic together. All decisions are made with those two priorities in mind. We appreciate your continued patience and support.
